He provides free counseling, information on all things having to do with Medicare, and Medicare-related subjects. Dick does not sell anything, ever. All his services are free. He also helps with problems and complaints or appeals if you feel your plan is not providing a benefit you need.

During the months of January, February and March, there is a special Medicare enrollment period for people who have Medicare advantage plans and who are interested in changing plans or dropping out of their plan and returning to original Medicare. Dick also has information on getting help with Medicare costs and Extra Help with

Prescription Drugs for people on limited incomes. This year there are also special savings plans for people using insulin for diabetic maintenance.
