Bulletin Board Project Update

This past spring, the Maintenance Board applied for the Oregon Parks & Recreation Department's Historic Cemetery Grant in hopes of securing funding to repair and re-erect our downed bulletin board. Disappointingly, we were not awarded the grant.

We moved forward anyway with repairs and as of mid-October, it has been re-installed. Several board members need to be thanked for their contribution in getting the bulletin board back in the upright position: John Hahn, James Luse and Larry Knudsen spent a very long day in rain and shine working on this project. We rented a lift to help get this done. Even though it was originally delivered in River View by mistake, the delay was minimal. Some tweaking will need to be done yet, as we lost some boards on the ridge and the main board in the middle needs to be turned around or replaced. We are so happy to get our main form of communication back and operating.

After communicating with the Grant Coordinator, we plan to reapply in 2025 for the chance to fund a headstone restoration project, which would address repairs of around twenty of our worst cracked, broken, and toppled headstones by working with a preservation organization. We hope to have an update by the spring newsletter.






Left: A rented lift reinstates the bulletin board. Right: Board Members James Luse and John Hahn secure the board to the new, recently installed steel brackets.
