**HOW TO REGISTER:**

Complete the sign-up form which is attached, completely with you and your child's information and submit today, mail to the TOOSS PO Box OR scan and email to Paige. Shortly after receiving your request to register, you will receive an email from Paige, with a link to make your payments. Three Oaks is requesting a non-refundable deposit of \$150.00 to secure your child's reservation. You may make payments or pay at once. FULL PAYMENT will be due 60 days prior to your trip. Less than 60 days prior to arrival day will result in a \$25 late fee. However, if you pay in full 120 days prior to arrival, your total fees will be \$25 LESS! If your child gets sick or suddenly is unable to go, **ALL FEES MINUS the \$150 deposit** will be refunded to the family.

## **FOUNTAIN VALLEY COMMUNITY CHAPERONES NEEDED:**

This design or organization of Science Camp for our students is very different than with schools and teachers involved. We will need adults to attend camp to assist in the supervision and leadership of the students attending from within your community. We are accepting parents of students attending to join in this role, however, it is to act as a leader for the community attending – not a parent of a child in camp. There will be expectations and assistance needed by the individuals chosen for this role. Our goal is to have one (1) chaperone per thirty (30) students, but a minimum of two (2) per community. There will be a fee of \$300 per chaperone; which covers: meals, accommodations separate from students, transportation to and from camp, the special fountain valley community camp t-shirt.

### **PRE-CAMP REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Must complete live-scan finger printing, at your expense to be submitted to Three Oaks Outdoor Science School.
2. Pay the camp fee of \$300. This fee is NOT REFUNDABLE, BUT TRANSFERABLE to another qualified chaperone.
3. Travel on the bus with students to and from camp.
4. Stay in camp the duration of the communities scheduled camp experience.
5. Collect camp paperwork – the Camp Consent and Medication Authorization forms – from every student prior to arriving at camp. Recommended to collect prior to departure day so that it can be assured both forms have been submitted for each student attending.
6. Must work with the community organizers to form and submit cabin lists to Three Oaks OSS two weeks prior to attending.
7. Must submit a list of any students with food allergies or restrictions (we are not interested in dislikes, just those foods that would send a student to the hospital), two weeks prior to attending.
8. Organize and attend a pre-camp meeting for all families attending. Three Oaks leadership will also attend to answer questions and help prepare everyone for the best experience possible.
9. Collect all medications being sent to camp from families and turn over to the medic upon arrival.

### **AT-CAMP REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Lead and conduct a one-hour activity for all students in your community. If attending a 5-day program, your activity time will be one hour after breakfast on Tuesday and Thursday of your week. If attending a 4-day program, your activity time will be one hour after breakfast on Thursday. This is a time where the Three Oaks staff need to have a daily meeting and break.
2. On Wednesday of your week, supervise the students during a wildlife presentation.
3. Must attend the student's skit night on the final night of camp to show support and encourage.
4. If a child is sitting out of program due to sickness, injury or discipline, one chaperone must sit with the child in case the Medic or Directors get a call for other issues.
5. We do not call home for homesick or to just check-in; you may not allow or organize phone calls home for students.
6. There is NO smoking or alcohol allowed on camp property.
7. You may and are encouraged to go hiking and participate in the program, however you are not there as a parent and should not be following your child around camp. This is also their adventure and experience to grow and discover without you.
8. Collect any medications from the medic and return to the families upon returning home.

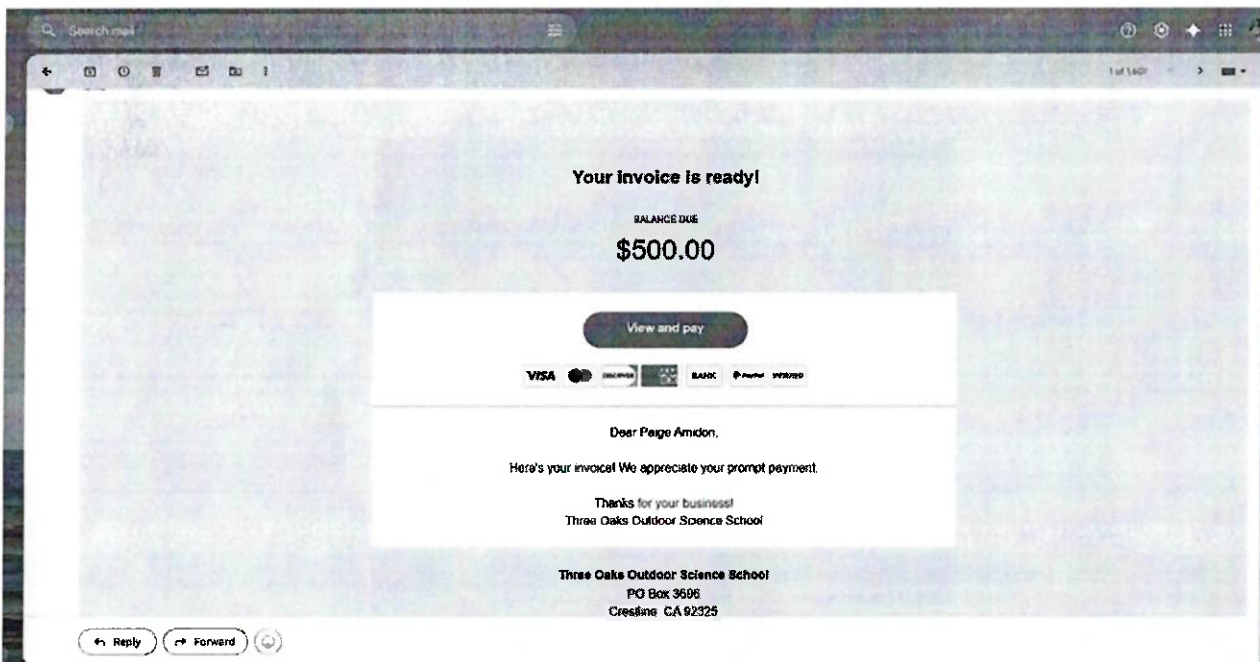


## THREE OAKS OUTDOOR SCIENCE SCHOOL FOUNTAIN VALLEY FAMILY PAYMENT DIRECTIONS

Upon submittal of a registration form, you will receive an email from Paige at Three Oaks with a link which will lead you to your family's invoice. You can then print and send a check or pay on-line via credit card or ACH using your bank information. Any payment online is subject to a fee; a 3.5% credit card charge OR 1% ACH charge.

As this is a new process for Three Oaks, we respectfully request your patience with us as we navigate this NEW way of organizing a group camp. It may be summer time you see your first email from Three Oaks. However if you have not received an email with your invoice link by August 15th, please email Paige.
