



COVID PREVENTION MEASURES AT CAMP:

Three Oaks Outdoor Science School will be reopening for the first time 19 months this January 2022! Our goal is to return students from across SoCal back to the outdoors for a safe, once in a lifetime adventure as this program has done since 1940. Once open, we will take precautions as necessary to keep camp open for many years to come. In order to do our best to assure a safe experience we will be taking the following measures:

SCHOOLS WILL BE REQUIRED TO TAKE THESE ACTIONS PRIOR TO CAMP:

1. Take the temperature of every student and teacher attending camp PRIOR to getting onto your bus transportation.
2. Be clear to families that students who present cold-like, flu-like and Covid type symptoms, the student will need to be picked up from camp.
3. Students should be encouraged to bring their own water bottle.

AT CAMP PROCEDURES:

1. All staff will be vaccinated.
2. Masks will be required indoors except when eating or drinking.
3. Dining hall will follow all health department guidelines as suggested for camp dining procedures.
4. Social Distancing when indoors and encouraged when outdoors.
5. Sleeping areas have been designed so that each bed area is its own cubicle space with a minimum of 6 feet distance from bunk across.
6. Sanitizer stations have been implemented throughout the camp.
7. Temperatures will be taken daily upon entry to breakfast.
8. We will call families to pick up any student displaying cold-like, flu-like or Covid type symptoms. We will error on the side of caution and safety.

These are all steps we are taking to assure a fun but safe adventure for all students, teachers and staff. These may change in time to keep up with local health department and state guidelines. We will also make sure students adhere to any specific rules set forth by their School and/or District which are not stated here on this list.
