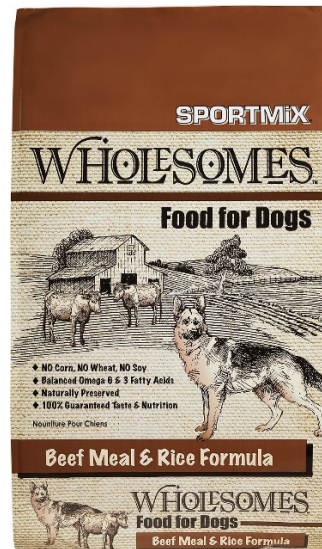
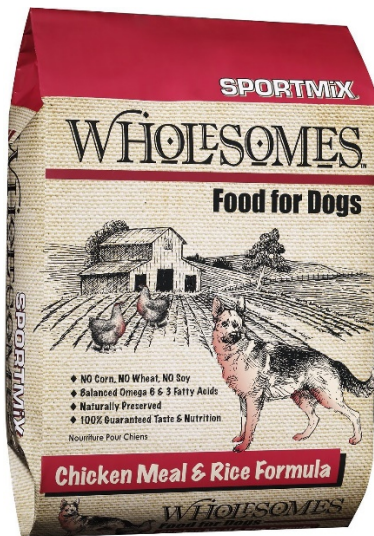
I first would like to express my most sincere thank you for choosing one of our pups to be your newest family member. We are so very blessed to have you as a part of our Dane family!!!

Just a few tips to get you thru the upcoming weeks of puppy hood!!

## FOOD

Start food transition right way to the food you plan on feeding. Reminder no puppy food or grain free unless documented by the vet they had a grain allergy. Also no Potato, sweet potato, peas or legumes as they are fillers and not a good source of nutrients. If moving from Sportmix Wholesome we recommend Purina Pro Plan, Royal Canin and Science Diet.

To get you started we have provided you with some of your puppies' current food to start blending in with your food of choice. This will help their tummy transition easily over to the new food. If you choose to continue them on the same food, we feed Sportmix Wholesome Chicken & Rice mixed with Sportmix Wholesome Beef & Rice.



## Crate & Leash

We recommend you start crate training & leash training right away. To help you be successful in going this we recommend you place a collar on your pup as soon as he/she arrives home. This will get them use t having it on their neck, then a couple days later attach a leash and let them drag it around until they are used to it being there. Crate training is also very important, we recommend a crate with dividers to use as they grow. Eventually this crate is what we use and gives them plenty of room.

## Bedding & Crate pads

The health of your pups joints, bones & muscles is very important. Four that we highly recommend that you purchase a really good orthopedic bed as well as a crate pad. We use and love K9 Ballistics for their indestructible bed.

## Supplements

One of the biggest things I see with puppies especially in the Giant Heavy Euros which is what I breed, is knuckling. For this I recommend your pup be on 1000mg of Vitamin C a day until at least 6 months old. I just use over the counter Vitamin Shoppe powder and sprinkle it on their food.



Another supplement we use and highly recommend is NuVet. This is NOT just a vitamin. It's an **immune system builder** with precise balance of vitamins, minerals, omega fatty acids, amino acids and high-potency antioxidants.
