What is the Associate Assistance Fund (AAF)? It is a 501c3 tax deductible charity designed to help BSRO teammates in need. It is designed to provide emergency financial assistance to any BSRO teammate who may require help recovering from a personal crisis (e.g. death, illness, etc.). Where do my donations go? Monetary donations are used by the fund to help BSRO teammates who find themselves in an emergency situation due to an unexpected event. These funds are either granted or loaned to the teammate and help keep their family safe by paying for necessities.

Can I use the AAF? The money you donate is a tax-deductible donation and can be used as a line item on your taxes. This is NOT a savings account. If you come upon an emergency situation you can ask the AAF for assistance. The decision to donate is entirely voluntary, and there is no obligation whatsoever to agree to donate. Whether or not you donate to the fund will not affect the decision in your case should you ask the AAF for assistance at any time. All submissions for assistance are completely confidential.
