

# WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT OUR 2026 FUNDRAISER

Due to overwhelming response last year, we will again be selling Gia Russa pepperoni rolls. We have also added a second option to sell Pizza Joe's cards. Each player, up to 2 players per family, will prepay for **1 case of pepperoni rolls OR 3 Pizza Joe's cards**. Total cost for each option is \$36/player. The \$36 due for the fundraiser has already been paid as part of your registration fees. This is the same prepay concept that we have used in the past, however, we have lowered the minimum amount required per player.

Similar to last year, each player will have the opportunity to sell more than the minimum, and we will have prizes for the top 3 sellers!

**1<sup>st</sup> place prize** - \$100 Athletix gift card

**2<sup>nd</sup> place prize** - \$50 Dick's gift card

**3<sup>rd</sup> place prize** - \$25 Handel's gift card

So, how will this work?

**Cost per case of rolls: \$36 and includes 12 rolls**

**Cost per Pizza Joes card: \$12 and includes a 12" cheese pizza**

1. You can download and print the order form from our Fundraising Page at any time to track your sales. This form is for you to help track sales and when it comes time to deliver. You will not need to turn in this order form.
2. Sell as many rolls or cards as you can! Remember, the rolls freeze well and make great after practice and game day snacks/dinners!
3. Fill out the Google form provided for each player that will be selling. You will include your player's name and the amount sold for each item. There are 3 options for rolls: Pepperoni, Spicy, and Italian. One change we are implementing this year is that the rolls can only be sold by the case (12 rolls/case). This will help with ordering and distribution. **ORDER FORMS ARE DUE MARCH 20<sup>TH</sup>**.
4. If your player sold more than 1 case of rolls or 3 Pizza Joe's cards, you will be required to stop by the North Lima fields on Saturday March 21<sup>st</sup> from 9:00am – 11:00am OR Sunday March 22<sup>nd</sup> from 2:00pm – 4:00pm to pay your balance. **NO LATE ORDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
5. When the rolls are in, we will provide pick up times. Pizza cards will be given to the coaches to hand out. More information to come as we are making some improvements!

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

- **How many rolls or cards do I put on the order form if I sold more than the minimum amount?**
  - You will enter the total amount sold, including the minimum mandatory amount of 1 case of rolls or 3 pizza cards - \$36/player
    - Ex: If you sold 5 cases of rolls, you would enter those 5 cases (by flavor) in the correct amount. You will have a balance of \$144 ( $\$36 \times 5 = \$180$ ,  $\$180 - \$36 \text{ prepaid} = \$144$ ). This amount would need to be paid during the March 21<sup>st</sup> / 22<sup>nd</sup> collection times.
    - Ex: If you sold 5 pizza cards, you would enter those 5 cards in the correct amount. You will have a balance of \$24 ( $\$12 \times 5 = \$60$ ,  $\$60 - \$36 \text{ prepaid} = \$24$ ) This amount would need to be paid during the March 21<sup>st</sup> / 22<sup>nd</sup> collection times.
- **What if I do not sell at least 1 case of rolls or 3 pizza cards?**
  - You will still have already paid for either 1 case of rolls or 3 pizza cards in the total amount of \$36. You could choose to keep the case of rolls or 3 pizza cards for a quick dinner on those busy game nights. We will only order what you turn in on the Google form. If you don't turn in for 1 case of rolls or 3 pizza cards, we will consider this as a donation to the league.
- **What if I have 2 children playing?**
  - You will need to turn in a separate Google form for each child. Each child will have 1 case of rolls or 3 pizza cards that are considered prepaid. They are not transferable between players, including siblings.
- **What if I have more than 2 children playing?**
  - You will only have prepaid for 2 children's mandatory amount. You can still have all of your children sell rolls or cards. You will still turn in a Google form for each amount sold attributed to each child.
- **What if I choose not to sell any rolls or cards?**
  - You will still have already prepaid for 1 case of rolls or 3 pizza cards per child (up to 2). You could choose to place an order for those and keep them for yourself and your family. **If you do not turn in the Google form provided, we will consider those fees that you have already paid as a donation to the league and you will not receive any rolls or cards.**
- **What if I forget to turn in my orders by the March 20<sup>th</sup> deadline?**
  - No late orders will be accepted. If we do not receive your order by the due date, we will consider your prepaid amount as a donation to the league.
- **How do I pay for my balance owed?**
  - You will need to stop by the North Lima fields during our posted collection times and pay your balance by cash or check.
- **What if I forget how much I owe?**
  - You will have access to your Google form answers along with the ability to edit it up until March 20<sup>th</sup>. If you still have trouble, please reach out to Amy Wells or Brandy Angus for assistance.
- **Are the prizes awarded for individual child or per family?**
  - The prizes for the top 3 sellers will be awarded on an individual level and determined by the orders placed on the provided Google form for each individual child. Winners will be announced on our social media page.
- **How do I get the rolls or cards that I sold?**
  - Once we have a delivery date confirmed by the company, we will make an announcement to all families when we will schedule pick up times. We are working on improved pick-up options for this year so stay tuned for more information! Pizza cards will be distributed to the coaches to pass out.
- **What if I cannot pick up my rolls or cards on the pick up day?**
  - Please reach out to Amy Wells or Brandy Angus and make arrangements for pick up. You may need to enlist a family member or friend to pick up your order for you. We have limited space to store rolls that are not picked up.
