
WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT OUR NEW FUNDRAISER

We have decided to try a new fundraiser this year instead of the pizza cards and raffle tickets. Everyone will have the opportunity to sell as many delicious Gia Russa pepperoni rolls as they can. Each player, up to two players per family, will prepay for 15 rolls. Rolls are \$3 each. The \$45 due for these 15 rolls will be collected as part of your registration fees. While this is a new fundraiser, this is the same prepay concept that we have used in years past except we lowered the minimum amount required per player.

Here's the great part this year... you will have the opportunity to sell more than 15 rolls and we will have a prize for the top 3 sellers!!



2nd place will receive a \$50 Dick's Sporting Goods gift card

3rd place will receive a \$25 Dairy Queen gift card

So, how will this work?

- 1. You can download and print the order form from our Fundraising Page at any time to track your sales. This form is for you to keep to help tracking sales and when it comes time for delivery. You will not turn in a paper form.
- 2. Sell as many rolls as you can by March 28th. Keep in mind they freeze well and make great Game Day snacks/dinners!
- 3. Fill out the Google Form provided for each player that will be selling rolls. You will include your player's name and amount sold. There will be 3 different kinds-Pepperoni, Spicy, and Italian. Be sure to mark the correct number for each kind. This will be due on or before March 28th.
- 4. If you sold more than 15 rolls, stop by our North Lima Fields on March 29th from 9-11am or 2-4pm or on Sunday, March 30th from 2-4pm to pay your balance. NO LATE ORDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED!
- 5. When the rolls are in, we will provide pickup times. You will need to plan on picking up your rolls at that time. We will have limited storage for unclaimed rolls. You will be responsible for distributing your rolls to your customers.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



- How many rolls do I put in the order form if I've sold more than the minimum mandatory amount?
 - You will enter your total amount sold including the minimum mandatory amount of 15 rolls/\$45 per player.
 - If you sell 40 rolls, you will enter those 40 rolls in the correct amount for each of the 3 kinds available. You will have a balance of \$75 owed (\$3 x 40 rolls = \$120; \$120 Prepaid \$45 = \$75). This amount will need paid during the March 29th/30th collection times.
- ➤ What if I do not sell at least 15 rolls?
 - You will still have already paid for 15 rolls. You could choose to keep the
 extra rolls for a quick dinner on those busy game nights. We will only order
 what you turn in on the Google form. If you turn in less than 15 rolls on the
 Google Form, we will consider the remaining balance a donation to the
 league.
- What if I have 2 children playing?
 - You will need to turn in a separate form for each child. Each child will have 15 rolls that are considered prepaid. They are not transferable between any players, including siblings.
 - If you sell 30 rolls between 2 kids and fill out the Google form as follows: one child sells 20 rolls and the other sells 10, you will owe a total of \$15 (\$3 x 5 rolls) for the first child and \$0 (they did not use up their minimum 15 rolls) for the second.
 - In the same family with the same total number sold for that family, if you fill out the Google form as follows: one child sells 15 and the other child sells 15, then you will not owe any more money since you have met the 30 rolls/\$90 mandatory amount for 2 players and this has already been paid for in your registration fees.
- What if I have more than 2 children playing?
 - You will only have prepaid for 2 children's mandatory amount. You can still have all of your children sell the pepperoni rolls. You will still turn in a Google Form for each with the amount sold attributed to each child.
 - If two of your children sell their mandatory 15 rolls or less, you will only owe for the amount that any other children have sold.
 - If at least two children sell more than the mandatory 15 rolls, you will owe a balance for however many those two children have sold beyond their individual 15 plus however many the remaining children have sold.
- What if I choose to not sell any rolls?
 - You will still have already paid for 15 rolls. You could choose to place an
 order for those 15 rolls and keep them for yourself and your family. If you
 do not turn in an amount using the Google Form provided, we will
 consider the fees that you have already paid a donation to the league.

- ➤ What if I forget to turn in my orders by the March 28th deadline?
 - We cannot accept late orders. If we do not receive your order by the due date, we will consider your prepaid amount a donation to the league.
 - If you encounter any problems with turning in your orders, please feel free to reach out to us and we will help you.
- > How do I pay for my balance owed?
 - You will need to stop by our North Lima fields during our posted collection times and pay your balance by cash or check. We ask that you enter via Nila Dr and exit using the old school exit. This will keep any lines moving quickly and make the whole process smooth and easy.
- > What if I forget how much I owe?
 - You will have access to your Google form answers along with the ability to edit it up until March 28th. If you still have trouble, we will have all of the balances owed at the payment collection event.
- > Are the prizes awarded for individual children or as a family?
 - The prizes for the top 3 sellers will be awarded on an individual basis and determined by the orders placed for each individual child's Google form. Winners will be announced on our social media pages and featured on our fundraising page on our website.
- ➤ How do I get the rolls I ordered?
 - When we are given a delivery date by the company we are using, we will make an announcement to all families when we will be at the fields for pick up. Pick up will be handled in the same manner as payment drop off. You will enter our North Lima complex via Nila Dr and exit via the old school exit. We will have all of the rolls organized by player.
- What if I cannot pick up the rolls on the pick up day?
 - You will need to reach out to Amy Wells or Brandy Angus and make arrangements for pick up. You may need to enlist a family member or friend to pick up your order for you. We have limited space to store any rolls that are not picked up. We do not want them to spoil before you can deliver them to your customers.
