## December 1, 2025 Meeting

### UPDATES FROM LAST MEETING

- Offseason Development notifications and sign-up form are ready to be sent out.
- Pitching Sessions sign up forms and notifications are ready to be sent out also.
- Evaluations were discussed and tentatively set for Feb 8 2:00-5:00 at Sluggers. This is Super Bowl Sunday. We may want to push that out a week. If so, this will impact Draft Deadlines
  - Push it back a week: Evaluations the 15th; Drafts the 22nd
- Indoor Practice time has been reserved at MNM Baseball for Fridays 5:00-7:00 and Saturdays 10:00-12:00 and 2:00-4:00 throughout March.
- FUNDRAISING: Pepperoni rolls are \$20/case with 12 per case. We need to have a concrete plan for the amount required before we can send out registration.
  - PEPPERONI ROLLS:
    - Sell by the case: One case (\$36 in fundraising) per child, \$72 (2 cases) per family max
    - \$3 a pepperoni roll, \$36 a case
    - Select case flavors at registration
    - Gift cards for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place in sales
    - Another Pepperoni Roll Sale in the Fall
    - Orders Due: Monday, March 30,
    - Pick up: 2 different orders Tuesday (4/14) and Thursday (4/16) days by last name or possibly use a refrigerated truck
  - Meat Cooler: Add 2nd and 3rd place (gift card to the meat place, lottery tickets), possibly start during all stars
  - Possibly selling Canfield Fair Tickets; concert tickets
  - Clothing Sale with OMG:
    - 5\$ per order
    - He will collect orders
    - Add umbrellas, blankets, jackets
    - Send home from school
    - Open Sales February 1- M End March 7 : Roll Out, we will have numbers by then to add customization
    - Keep it open through the season, with a QR Code by the concession stands

- New equipment bags have been ordered and numbered
  - Next Year: Turn in day to inventory supplies, and hold coaches accountable and know what is missing
  - Dicks: look into sponsorship or possible donations, also a shopping date with a coupon to buy them on sale
  - Strongly recommend to families that they purchase padded heart guards for under uniform
- We are waiting on final approval from Beaver Township for the electric to be run from the concession stand to the new shed.
- 10U Baseball Winter Workouts filled up fast!! They are full with a waitlist
- 10U Softball has been working out of David Stack's garage under the direction of TJ Arundel

#### Little League Meeting Notes

- There will be an update this year to how background checks and ASAP Safety Plans are completed.
  - Background checks will be able to be completed directly through Sports Connect. It looks like we may not have to send out individual emails with links to individuals.
  - There will be a new format for the ASAP Safety Plans that will launch in January that will include two new initiatives- "Little League SAFE" and "SAFE to Play"
- Mandatory coaching meeting for going over safety procedures

#### Registration for 2026

- Registration cost will be increased by \$10 with families able to lock in last year's rate if they register by December 31<sup>st</sup>. Registration will close January 31<sup>st</sup> with a \$20 late fee after that.
- Insurance is due to be renewed by January 9<sup>th</sup>. I will have a quote soon.
- Uniform Quotes: Mark has not given any details yet on design for the coming season. Last season we paid \$22 for 8U-12U jerseys, \$43 for Pony Baseball, \$37 for Pony Softball, and \$12 for T-Ball.
  - We will offer an option to buy extra jerseys at an increased cost. It was suggested that we charge \$5 over cost. As I set up registration, it became clear that this would be very difficult through Sports Connect. We may need to have a separate form.
- Set up a google form on the website to order an extra jersey

#### Other New Business

- Pastor Brian Regal from Paradise Church on New Buffalo Rd reached out about helping to make use of a grass area behind their church. Jeff and I went to see what might be possible
  - There would be room for a full infield making it a usable practice space for almost all age groups as well as a game location for T-Ball.
