

# South Range Baseball Registration (SRBA) - Registration Agreement

## Registration will close on February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022

1. Registrations may be cancelled with full refund if cancelled before March 31, 2022. In order to qualify for a full refund, fundraiser items must be returned. The value of fundraiser items not returned will be deducted from the final amount paid in the refund. Registrations cancelled on or after March 31, 2022 will not be eligible for a refund under any circumstances. Payment will not be collected during registration, further details in regards to payment will be communicated after the close of registration. Please note all registration fees will be due in full on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of practice.
2. Special requests for managers and/or teammates will not be accepted.
3. Players wishing to register after the close of registration (Feb. 20th) will be considered on a case by case basis and will be dependant on roster counts.
4. Playing Up:
  - a. For Baseball and softball, families wishing to register their player in the next level up from where our age chart determines they should play may do so only if the player is 1 year away from being eligible for the upper age group. HOWEVER, this does not guarantee the right to play up. We will do our best to accommodate these players, but reserve the right to deny a request to play up. Decisions will be based on team roster counts and player safety. When registering, families will be charged the playing fee associated with the upper age group. If it is determined after the close of registration that we cannot accommodate a request to move up, a refund in the amount of the cost difference between the upper and lower level will be issued. If a family decides to cancel their registration, a full refund minus fundraiser items not returned will be issued.
  - b. For baseball there is one exception to the above rule. Players born in May through August will be given first consideration for playing up. The basis for this rule is to allow players the opportunity to play based on the Little League age determination date of August 31<sup>st</sup> vs the April 30<sup>th</sup> age determination date we use in the Mahoning Columbiana League
  - c. For T-Ball age players wishing to play up to 8U, only those players of playing age 6 according to their respective age chart who have at least 1 year of playing experience may register up to 8U. As with baseball and softball, if it is determined after the close of registration that we cannot accommodate a request to move up, a refund in the amount of the cost difference between the upper and lower level will be issued. If a family decides to cancel their registration, a full refund minus fundraiser items not returned will be issued.
5. Birth Certificates must be provided upon request

14U	\$115 /Player	Baseball Ages 13-14 - Softball Ages 13-15

\*\* A one time Capital Campaign Fee of \$20 per family is required. Again this year we are allowing families to receive an additional \$20 in raffle tickets to sell to recoup this \$20 fee. If you would like the additional tickets add an extra 4 raffle tickets to your fundraising options during registration.

\*\* SRBA has a Mandatory Fundraising requirement of \$55 per child, up to 2 children (max \$110). Fundraising fees are collected with registration. When you sell your items you keep the money as a means to recoup your fundraising costs.
