

SRBA/ LEAGUE CODE OF CONDUCT

No Board Member, Manager, Coach, Player, Parent or Spectator shall at any time:

- Will not violate the posted speed limit signs at field locations. Speed in parking lots of 5 MPH. Watch for kids and spectators.
- Use Alcohol, Tobacco, Smoke or Vape in the parking lot, fields or the complex.
- Lay a hand upon, push, shove, strike, or threaten to strike an umpire
- Be verbally or physically abusive towards any Umpire, Player, Coach or fellow spectators for any real or imaginary belief of a wrong decision or judgment
- Show an objectionable demonstration of dissent at an umpire's decision by throwing gloves, helmets, hats, bats, balls, or any other forceful unsportsmanlike-like action
- Use unnecessarily rough tactics in the play of a game against the body of an opposing player
- Use profane, obscene or vulgar language in any manner at any time
- Appear on the field of play, stands, or anywhere on a SRBA complex while in an intoxicated state at any time
- Participate in gambling upon any play or outcome of any game with anyone at any time
- Discuss publicly with spectators in a derogatory or abusive manner any play, decision or a personal opinion of any players during the game
- Speak disrespectfully to any manager, coach, umpire or representative of the league
- Tamper with or manipulate any league rosters, schedules, draft positions or selections, official score books, rankings, financial records or procedures
- Challenge an umpire's authority. The umpires shall have the authority and discretion during a game to penalize the offender according to the infraction up to and including removal from the game
- Enter the field of play, for the purpose of physically or verbally abusing or confronting coaches, players or umpires
- Throw and/or deposit any object onto the field of play.
- Players shall not leave the dugout during games unless you are given permission by one of the coaches.
- Leave or deposit garbage of any kind in the dugout, field, spectator areas, or parking lots. After each game or practice at any location, players and coaches must clean the dugouts of all equipment and garbage.

No spectator shall address any on-field participants directly or indirectly before, during, or after a game in a manner which is not considered positive, encouraging, and complimentary.

The Board of Directors will review all infractions of the SRBA Code of Conduct. Depending on the seriousness or frequency, the board may assess additional disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from the league. These CODE of CONDUCT rules apply to the all events that fall under the authority of South Range Baseball Association as well as Little League Baseball and Softball and are not limited to South Range fields. If the CODE of CONDUCT is violated at an away game or event, disciplinary action may also be taken by the SRBA Board.

This Code of Conduct applies not only to South Range games but also includes the fellow towns we play at home or away at their fields

The CODE of CONDUCT form will need to be signed and turned in for the player to receive his/her game jersey
