

Passport (valid for at least 6 months beyond your trip)

- Visas (if required for certain Caribbean islands)
- Accommodation confirmations (hotel, Airbnb, resort, etc.)
- Check in online. Print your flight information
- Travel insurance details (medical) and trip cancellation coverage)
- Noise-canceling headphones
- Power bank or portable charger
- Camera gear (extra memory cards, batteries)
- Universal charger adapter

Island, Essentials

- Light, breathable clothing (cotton) or linen)
- Swimwear and cover-ups
- Beach hat and sunglasses
- Flip-flops or sandals for the beach, Comfortable walking shoes.
- Evening wear (if dining at upscale) restaurants)
- Sunscreen and insect repellent a

Money & Payments

- Cash (some islands prefer USD, others use local currency)
- Notify your bank of travel dates (to avoid card being blocked)
 - Small bills for tips and street vendors (Do not walk around with loads of cash)

Island-specific Considerations

- Transportation: Rent a car, book taxis, or arrange airport transfers in advance
- Local Etiquette & Customs: Familiarize yourself with the local culture and any customs
- Weather Check: Monitor weather forecasts to pack accordingly
- Local SIM card or international plan: For communication and navigation.
- Research local festivals or events happening during your stay
