The IGG/IGM test detects the antibodies that show whether you may or may not have had the COVID 19.

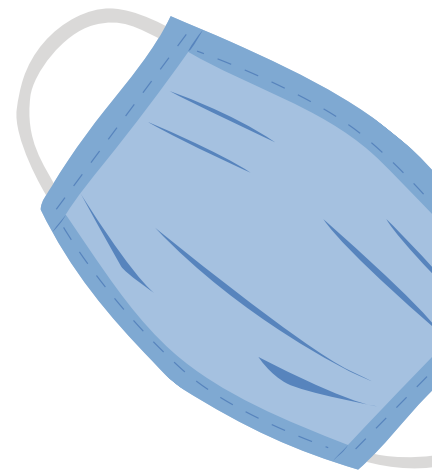
\*This is not a diagnostic test for COVID-19

If you have fever, cough, or difficulty breathing, seek care from your primary care physician.

**How to get a test:** Come by our Wellness Lab at 3501 Soncy Ste 116 to get an IGG/IGM test for \$ 84.00. A mask is required for all patients.

**Expected turn around time** is 24 hours.

# WHAT IS IGG/IGM TEST?

The IGG/IGM are antibody tests that check your blood looking for antibodies, which may tell you if you had a past infection with the virus that causes COVID-19.

Antibody tests should NOT be used to diagnose a current COVID-19 infection. An antibody test may not show if you have a CURRENT COVID-19 infection because it can take 1-3 weeks after the infection for your body to make antibodies.

You may test positive for antibodies even if you have not had symptoms of COVID-19. This happens when you have the infection without symptoms, this is called asymptomatic infection.

Regardless of your results you should always talk to your healthcare provider with any concerns.

## IF YOU TEST NEGATIVE:

- Continue to protect yourself & others
- Discuss any concerns with your healthcare provider
- Continue to monitor any symptoms

Remember you could still get sick if you have been exposed to the virus.

## IF YOU TEST POSITIVE:

- CONTINUE TO PROTECT YOURSELF & OTHERS
- Talk to your doctor about your results & see if they recommend nasal test for further evaluation
- Follow general recommendations to prevent infection and resume normal activities including work

# 7 Steps to prevent the spread of COVID-19

- 01** Wash your hands frequently
- 02** Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth
- 03** Cover your mouth when you cough using a tissue or the bend of your elbow
- 04** Avoid crowded places and close contact with anyone who has fever or cough
- 05** Stay home if you feel unwell
- 06** Seek medical care early if you have a fever, coughs, and difficulty breathing—but call first
- 07** Get information from trusted sources

# Q & A



## **What types of tests are available?**

PPL/Walk-In Wellness Lab is currently only providing the IGG/IGM panel testing for the COVID-19 antibodies.

## **Where can I get tested?**

We are offering the IGG/IGM tests at our Soncy lab location which is 3501 Soncy Suite 116.

## **Do I have to have an appointment for the test?**

You are not required to schedule an appointment however we do recommend that you call ahead of time and check availability.

## **What are the hours of the lab?**

Hours of the lab are Monday - Friday 7:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

## **How soon do I get my results?**

Results are provided within 24 to 48 hours from the time the test was taken.

## **How much is the test?**

The COVID-19 IGG/IGM tests are \$84 and can be paid via credit card, debit card, or cash.

## **Does insurance cover the test?**

This IGG/IGM test is not covered by insurance at our facility

## **Can I get my results online?**

You may access results via an app by texting APGPPL to 66349 or visit <http://mylabsnow.luminatehealth.com/common/signup> (must have date of test collection in order to retrieve results)

## **Can my doctor get my results?**

Your physician may request results at any time
