Program information:

When will the trees be planted? Spring and/or Fall 2018

Why? To help replace some of the many ash trees which have died because of the Emerald Ash Borer; to beautify our neighborhood; to help our environment; to help our property values; to assist the neighbors in getting trees.

What kind of trees? Homeowners will be able to choose from to be provided.

How much? Between \$125 and \$200, cost varies by tree species.

Delivery fee will be included in the cost.

Who will dig holes? Andy Anderson, the Downers Grove Township Highway Commissioner, has offered his crew to dig holes in the parkway

Will anyone help me? The TreeKeeper volunteers from The Morton Arboretum and hopefully other able bodied residents will help each other.

What if I can't afford the tree? Timberlake Civic Association is considering subsidizing the tree planting project for Timberlake Civic Association members. We will also have a tree planting fund for anyone that would like to donate to the project for the good of the neighborhood.
