

Endometriosis

This study found that a combined treatment consisting of magnetic-infrared-laser therapy (10–15 min/day ever other day over a period of 10–14 exposures, then repeated in 2–3 months) and conventional drug therapy proved highly effective in women suffering from endometriosis. (1)
