

HOW TO MAKE A Fleece Beanie

You need at least ¼ of fleece fabric. Fabric designs for men, women, and children.

1. Cut out the fabric making sure the stretch is at the bottom/hem. Make sure that if the fabric has a particular pattern (like a flower, face, wording, etc.) it needs to be right side up on the pattern pieces.
- SIDE SEAMS**
2. With right sides together, fold one side of beanie so that cut edges of top points match. Pin.
 3. Starting at top point, stitch edges together at 3/8". Taper stitching at folded side, stitching of edge at pin marking.
 4. Zigzag stitch seam allowances together.
 5. Making sure you are folding with right sides together, repeat steps 2-4 at opposite edge of beanie.

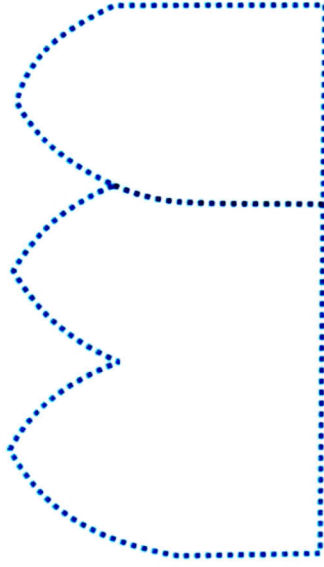
BACK SEAM

6. Fold beanie in half with right sides together, matching cut edges of fabric. At center top, match two previous seam lines. Pin, with two previous seam allowances going in opposite directions to reduce bulk.
7. Starting at bottom edge and continuing across top of beanie, stitch together at 3/8", tapering off folded edge at end of stitching as before.
8. Zigzag stitch seam allowances together.

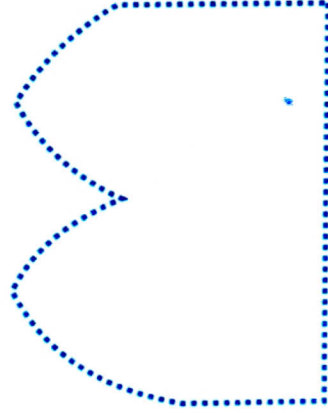
HEM

9. Fold 1 ¼" to wrong side around bottom of beanie. Pin in place.
10. Zigzag stitch hem in place close to cut edge.
11. Turn beanie right side out. COMPLETE!

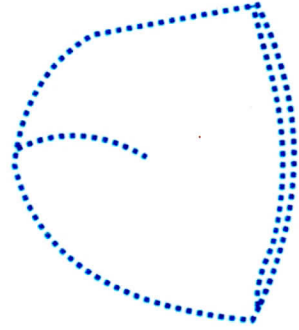
SIDE SEAM #1
