Only one "Graduating Senior" scholarship shall be awarded annually, and applicants are only eligible once.

This scholarship awards \$1,000 and is paid directly to the student upon proof of enrollment in a post-secondary academic institution. You may be interviewed by a scholarship committee member if selected as a finalist.
