Required Attachments:

1. **Personal Statement:** One-page essay answering: "How have youth programs like the Boys & Girls Club influenced the direction of your life, and why do you believe these programs are important for future generations?"
2. **Letter of Recommendation:** From a teacher, community leader, or non-family member who knows you well.

Selection Criteria:

The selection process will consider the following:

- **Community Impact & Service:** Demonstrated commitment to positively impacting others and serving the community.
- **Personal Growth & Reflection:** Evidence of maturity, leadership development, and thoughtful reflection on life experiences.
- **Club Connection & Values:** How the Boys & Girls Club has influenced the applicant's character, values, and future direction.

Scholarship Details:

- **Award Amount:** \$1,000 to one deserving high school junior or senior.
- **Application Deadline:** March 31, 2026
- **Notification:** Recipients will be notified by April 30, 2026.
