Maintaining Hundreds of Beautiful Smiles!

Agape's annual volunteer dental team is enjoying significant results. "It is amazing how having stains cleaned from a child's teeth improves their self-esteem. It's like dressing them up in the best clothes and putting them in the King's palace!" said team leader Dr. Ken Brede, DMD.

That is why the children take what they have learned about dental care seriously. Many of the children had never ever seen a dentist before coming to Agape.

The work for volunteers is a challenge, with long hot days and more than 230 patients to treat. Each year, however, improvements such as air conditioning, a generator, and x-ray equipment help maximize the team's efforts. And with five years of annual treatments, the critical care some initially required has progressed to simple maintenance.

Orthodontic care is still limited, but many children like Lavayna have had crooked smiles corrected with regular "finger pressure" treatments they are instructed to do three times each day and an extraction if needed.
