Nandhini came to Agape barely clinging on to life. Her long list of health problems included a lung infection, pneumonia, HIV positive with a low CD4 count. This fragile little girl also suffered seizures and was battling severe diarrhea and malnourishment. She could not sit or stand.

Lynne the founder and director of Agape, with her caring and "never give up" spirit took up the challenge. With her team of doctors, Agape staff, medical insurance and many months in the hospital, Nandhini has made a remarkable recovery. After a year of TLC, she has put on weight and can walk a little. She has no major medical issues now.

The head pediatric doctor checking up on her could hardly recognise Nandhini. He saw how far she had come and called her 'A Miracle Baby'. He gave her a kiss and had the whole team of doctors witness the transformation. She still has some lingering developmental issues. We are rooting for her to be a healthy child as soon as possible and have happy years ahead.
