Dr. Keasha Hawkins is a faith-based counselor, life management coach, Resiliency Specialist and entrepreneur.

Dr. K. Hawkins is a native of the south side Chicago, IL but raised on North side of Omaha, NE. She is the mother of 3 adopted children, raising them and nurturing her relationship with God is her greatest joy.

She is the Nebraska Democratic Party's finance director. She previously led the party's constituent outreach. She continues to pour into her community through volunteering and so much more in numerous compacities such as food drives, mentoring our youth, assisting communities in improving their value, integrity and culture. She has been a vital component of positive change in the North Omaha area.

Pastor P has been leading her community for several years ensuring that they are not only receiving spiritual nutriment through the word of God on Sundays and Wednesdays at Claire Memorial United Methodist Church, but ensuring that people in her community don't go hungry. Over the past year, Pastor Cavitt has been instrumental in making sure members of North Omaha and surrounding communities have access to healthy food for their families, and by keeping the community informed on the coronavirus hosting weekly Facebook lives with health care professionals. Most recently she's been the lead community member organizing vaccination clinics at Girls Inc. partnering with the Douglas County Health Department. Pas. P has a heart of Gold and a heart after God to ensure that she is doing all that God wants her to do for HIS people.

Community Trailblazer Award
Gladys Harrison



Gladys Harrison is a Nebraska native and the mother of 3 adult children and one grandson who is the apple of her eye - She is the youngest of four daughters. Being a servant to the community, Gladys has served on the board of Greater Omaha Community Action and as a volunteer for various community organizations. In 2007, Gladys and her sisters helped their mother achieve her lifelong dream by opening Big Mama's Kitchen and Catering. Big Mama's prioritizes providing job opportunities for felons and job skills opportunities for members of the community who have never been employed. Sadly, Big Mama passed away in 2018, however the restaurant remains a family-owned under Gladys' leadership as the owner and president. In January 2020 the restaurant moved to its new location the Highlander Dining Room which is North Omaha's first and only food and drink hub.

In honor of their late mothers' legacy of changing lives, Gladys and her family have also established the Patricia "Big Mama" Barron Scholarship Fund for culinary students targeting those students needing a second chance.

In May of 2022 Gladys was selected to be a board member for the United Way of the Midlands. Gladys' plans for the future are to create economic opportunities that will enable herself, her family and her community to build wealth their way.



Courage Award Briannah Harrison

Briannah is a single mother who has changed her life around not only for her son Brayden but for herself. As a child and into her teens Briannah was very shy never wanting to be in the front. Briannah had some difficult times in the past, but with God and the help of her family she was able to overcome and begin to work on improving her life. 
TEEN Community Trailblazer Award


