



Trip Planner

Included in your Stay:

- Accommodations, Fridge, Stove, Microwave, Coffee maker, Propane BBQ, Charcoal grill, Shower, Towels, All Bedding including pillows, Satellite T.V, WIFI, Drinking Water, All needed cookware, cutlery, dishes, cups etc. You don't have to bring anything but food & drinks.

What to Bring:

- Weapon of choice (Rifle, Bow, Crossbow)
- Safety Harness
- A day pack is recommended as you could be spending extended time in the stand. Something you can pack snacks, drinks etc in.
- Manitoba Hunters safety or equivalent from your state or province, A current game license from your state will also work

- Various hunting gear. Be prepared for cooler temps and possible rain. Temps are between 45-65 degrees.
Hunter Orange is also required for fall hunts. (Vest & Hat)

- Bugs are not bad but bring a Thermacell if you have one
- Fishing is available close by at Rossman lake (Walleye & Northern Pike) Bring your fishing rod and Lures. Licenses and Bait can be obtained locally
- Golf Clubs (Golf course located right across the road from the lodge)
- Flashlight or headlamp
- Food & Drinks can be purchased locally. If you plan on bringing either across the border please check the CBSA website on what you can and can't bring.
- Light Footwear for inside the lodge and footwear for around the firepit/deck area
- Large Coolers for Meat & Cape
