## CHAMPAGNE

- 101 Champagne Paul D'Angin, France.....88**  
(95% Pinot Noir, 5% Chardonnay. Under a pale yellow color, the effervescence emerges with a lightness showing beautiful persistence. The fine and elegant nose exalts notes of cookies and pears. The palate is balanced and creamy, it begins with a straightforward attack, then comes a gourmet side that ends with notes of almond. A champagne for all occasions!)
- 102 Champagne Brut Rosé, Louis Dumont, France.....89**  
(30% Chardonnay, 20% Pinot Meunier, 50% Pinot Noir. An elegant salmon-pink color with a delicate and silky nose of red fruits aromas. The palate is well-balanced and seducing with a delicate and fruity finish.)
- 103 Champagne Premier Cru Brut Louis Dumont, France.....94**  
(A blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. These grapes, blended in fairly equal quantities, give the wines of Champagne their wonderful flavors and aromas, with the Pinot Noir offering length and backbone, and the Chardonnay varietal giving its acidity and dry, biscuity nature.)

## PROSECCO

- 104 Prosecco Fiol, Italy.....51**  
(100 % Glera grape. Refreshing, and smooth, with beautifully balanced acidity and moderate alcohol content. FIOLE Prosecco is lively and refreshing on the palate with an elegant bouquet of white flowers, acacia and the tangy sweetness of mature crisp apples and pears.)
- 105 Prosecco DOC Rosé Fiol, Italy.....52**  
(85% Glera & 15% Pinot Noir. This refreshing and elegant expression captivates with its harmonious blend, graceful elegance, and invigorating freshness. It shows fruity aromas of raspberry and wild strawberry with hints of citrus lemons and white flowers.)

## FRANCIORTA

- 106 Franciacorta Bellaviata Alma Gran Cuvee Brut.....79**  
(77% Chardonnay, 1% Pinot Bianco, 22% Pinot Nero. Bright yellow in color with green reflections. The nose is characterized by marked minerality and notes of sweet ripe fruit, meringue, pastry and candied peel. The palate is fruit-driven with a creamy mouthfeel and a texture that combines elegance and harmony.)

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## ROSÉ WINE

- 107 Rosé, Favugne, Italy.....48**  
(Montepulciano grapes. Vivid and joyful rosy colour, with a background of pomegranate, pink peppercorn and hints of strawberries. Soft and fine palate with a long aromatic persistence.)
- 108 Rosé Pinotage Premium, South Africa.....54**  
(Pinotage grapes. Red fruit flavours of cherry and strawberry give way to minty freshness gleaned from earlier picked fruit. Lightly tinted from red grape skins, this salmon hued wine is fruity and juicy on the palate. Low in tannins, it displays delightful notes of melon, ripe tropical fruit and strawberry.)

## SWEET WINE

- 109 Moscato, Astra, White Sweet, Italy.....49**  
(Moscato of yellow colour with golden hints. A perfect choice for those who revel in sweet, fruity flavors reminiscent of peaches and orange blossom.. Its taste is sweet, pleasant, slightly effervescent.)
- 110 Sangue di Giuda, Red Sweet, Italy.....48**  
(Croatina, Uva Rara, Barbera grapes. A sweet wine of a bright ruby red. Full bodied and vinous, with notes of violets together with raspberry and blueberry jams, smooth and fragrant.)

## WHITE WINE

- 111 Pinot Grigio, Favugne, Puglia, Italy.....48**  
(100% Pinot Grigio. Brilliant straw yellow color with gold hints. The aroma is intense, full and fruit forward. Crisp with excellent persistence.)
- 112 Pinot Gris, Sweet Cheeks, Oregon.....52**  
(100% Pinot Gris. The wine displays bright, youthful flavors of orange peel, citrus and granny smith apple. Nicely balanced, this Pinot Gris is elegant and traditional, yet vibrant and fresh-faced.)
- 113 Chardonnay, Branciforti, Sicilia, Italy.....48**  
(Straw yellow colour with greenish tints. A generous wine with an elegant and refined bouquet, expressing on the palate delicate and harmonic hints of exotic fruits that exalt its pleasantness)

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## WHITE WINE

- 114 Chardonnay Domaine Sonoma, CA.....52**  
(Exceptional depth of color Citrus-lemon nose with suggestions of vanilla, rich and supple on the palate. Deep flavors derived from patient aging. Long, smooth finish.)
- 115 Chardonnay William Clark, WA.....48**  
(Aromas of ripe pear, lemon, and green apple. Pleasant and bright in the mouth, it features a classic expression of light toast and lemon oil. Contrasting flavors of white pepper and nuances of nutmeg add interest and carry the wine through to a flavorful finish.)
- 116 Sauvignon Blanc Laguna, Veneto.....48**  
(Straw yellow color with green highlights. Very clean nose with intense, fresh tropical fruit, pink grapefruit and vegetal aromas. Good structure with lively acidity, dry and medium length finish)
- 117 Sauvignon Blanc, Waipara, New Zeland.....56**  
(Punchy herbaceous characters of nettle and passionfruit with a touch of tropical fruit can be found on the nose. It is juicy and lively on the palate whilst still having super balance, texture and concentration coupled with chalky minerality.)
- 118 Sauvignon Blanc, Emmolo, CA.....48**  
(Fresh and clean, with white peach, wet stone and clementine notes. Bright lemon blossom on entry, with additional echoes of peach. Smooth texture, lasting freshness and a mouthwatering finish leave you wanting another sip.)
- 119 Chablis, Joel Sault, France.....70**  
(100% Chardonnay grape. This wine is a beautiful pale yellow color tinged with green. Lovely citrus aromas lead way to fruit-forward flavors of fresh pear with a rounded mouthfeel.)
- (120) Chablis Grand Cru Bougros, Domaine du Colombier, France.....138**  
(100% Chardonnay grapes. This is transporting on the nose, showing an entire world of generous, almost tropical fruit, sweet-crunchy apple, and candied lemon peel against an assertive hit of chalk. On the palate, there is weight and texture underpinned by excellent energy, with honey and lemon drops, hard stone fruit, and apple sweeping in on the hazelnut-flecked finish.)
- 121 Meursault, Philippe le Hardi, France.....175**  
(100% Chardonnay grapes. Full and round, this wine is fruity while smooth and rich. A layer of crisp acidity is surrounded by the generous white and yellow fruits, accented by a touch of toast and spice. Meursault, although fundamentally dry, gives the palate a mellow impression. It is distinguished by an exquisite nutty taste and a wide range of aromas.)

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## WHITE WINE

- 122 Vermentino, Perla Rara, Sardegna, Italy.....61**  
(100% Vermentino grape. Straw yellow. The nose is pleasantly intense and expresses itself with hints of tropical fruits and notes of white flowers. The palate is fresh, with good flavor and splendidly fine.)
- 123 Langhe Arneis, Terre del Barolo, Italy.....51**  
(100% Arneis grape. This is a classic example of Arneis with a glowing lemon color, the bouquet is delicate, fresh, and fruity with notes of almond, peach, and fresh pear. The palate is dry, crisp, and elegantly harmonic with moderate acidity.)
- 124 Gavi, Bersano, Piedmont Italy.....54**  
(100% Cortese grape. Bright straw yellow color with greenish reflections. On the nose it is characteristic and fragrant with refined floral notes and intense fruity hints of pineapple and peach. Fresh, harmonious and elegant with a full and soft body. Fruity and persistent finish.)
- 125 Gewurztraminer / Riesling Fusion, Pillitteri, Canada.....52**  
(60% Gewurztraminer, 40% Riesling grapes. It is highly aromatic with green apple, lychee, pink grapefruit and rose petal characters. The palate follows nose, with the addition of honey, ripe peach, tangerine and subtle undertones of honeydew melon.)

## RED WINE

- 126 Cabernet Sauvignon, Heros, Lazio, Italy.....48**  
(Medium to full-bodied. Ruby garnet red in color, with a slight purple rim. Classic, earthy aromas of wild berries, cherry, and blackcurrant, with notes of dried herbs, baking spices. rich on the palate.)
- 127 Cabernet Sauvignon, Domaine Sonoma, CA.....54**  
(Intense color. Berry fruit aromas. Classic Cabernet depth of flavor with hint of spice and pepper. Oak complexity smooth finish.)
- 128 Cabernet Sauvignon, Justin, Paso Robles, CA.....67**  
(Medium to full body. Deeply colored with a dark ruby core. Aromas of ripe red and black cherry notes, cigar box, and toasted oak with savory elements of vanilla and caramel with fresh sage, and hints of cocoa. The fresh midpalate turns savory with dried herbs, barrel spice, and vanilla supported by smooth tannins. The complex finish shows lingering ripe red and black fruit and spice mixed with dark caramel, dried floral notes, and mint elements.)

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## RED WINE

- 129 Cabernet Sauvignon, McNab Ridge, Largo, CA.....98**  
(The wine has a beautiful black cherry character with distinct aromas and flavors of cassis, cocoa, elegant cigar box and beautiful dark fruits. This full-bodied and balanced wine has a richly woven texture and a lingering finish that displays evolving dark berry, vanilla and baking spice flavors.)
- 130 Cabernet Sauvignon Faust, Napa Valley, CA.....120**  
(Delicate violet notes lift the dark fruit on the nose—black currant and briary blackberry—layered with pungent forest botanicals, leafy tobacco, graphite, and toasted spice. The velvet of fine-textured tannins backs expressive red fruit flavors on a complex palate, both sweet and savory with mocha and minerality, juicy ripe fruit and freshness)
- 131 Cabernet Sauvignon Caymus, 50th Anniversary, Napa Valley, CA. 1.0 L .....145**  
(Full Body. A classic Caymus Cab with a round, plush texture and tons and tons of flavor. The bouquet is a lively mélange of plum compote, chocolate, Kirsch and vanilla bean and the palate has an easy-to-love softness that neatly hides some real tannins and good acidity.)
- 132 Cabernet Sauvignon Far Niente, Napa Valley, CA.....199**  
(Opens with beautifully lifted spice and black fruit aromatics—clove, anise, black cherry and blackberry—layered with a hint of rich oak. A round, supple entry leads to a silky, smooth midpalate. Cassis, clove, and toasted oak complement the black and red fruit flavors. Fine-grained, age-worthy tannins provide structure to the dark, juicy finish.)
- 133 Cabernet Sauvignon, Cloisonné, Napa Valley.....79**  
(85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Petite Verdot, 7% Cabernet Franc. A complex wine with layers of deep black fruits. Deep aromas of black cherry, dried herbs, black tea, cedar, and cigar box. Long finish with baking spices on the palate.)
- 134 Cabernet Sauvignon Gran Reserva, Puntí Ferrer, Chile.....59**  
(Cabernet Sauvignon grape. Intense ruby red color. Intense nose of strawberry, forest, licorice and a faint animal quality. Round and well-structured. Vanilla, chocolate and licorice in a long finish.)
- 135 Merlot, Eterna, Lazio, Italy.....48**  
(Merlot grapes, this exemplary wine is obtained for its fruity flavor and intense and precious structure. A soft, warm red with a good alcohol content, tannins that manage to be remembered for the round and intense flavor they leave in the mouth.)
- 136 Merlot, Lady Hill, Columbia Valley, WA.....64**  
(Classic plump, luscious berry notes and dark plum ooze from the glass supported by a push from vanilla bean and butterscotch. Herbaceous highlights of tobacco leaf and fennel adds the complexity. Sweet up front, with a weighted but balanced mid to finish, and a juicy, lingering finish.)

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## RED WINE

- 137 Merlot, Emmolo, Napa Valley, CA.....69**  
(A wonderfully rich, earthy, dark and well-balanced Merlot. Smooth upon entry, with a richness that builds. Flavors of cherry, spice and savory bread carry over from the nose, with lush plums and a hint of jerky. Dusty, powdery tannins lend softness. French oak character comes through on the nose, palate and lingering finish.)
- 138 Pinot Noir, Signoria, Lazio.....49**  
(A delicate bouquet of red cherries. A fresh and light-bodied red, it is balanced with mild tannins that round out the finish.)
- 139 Pinot Noir, Bourgogne, France.....66**  
(Delicate violet notes lift the dark fruit on the nose—black currant and briary blackberry—layered with pungent forest botanicals, leafy tobacco, graphite, and toasted spice. The velvet of fine-textured tannins backs expressive red fruit flavors on a complex palate, both sweet and savory with mocha and minerality, juicy ripe fruit and freshness)
- 140 Pinot Noir, Belle Glos “Dairyman”, Russian River Valley, CA.....65**  
(Deep garnet in color with abundant aromas of sun-warmed black cherry, raspberry compote, and dark chocolate followed by hints of cedar and black currant. Bold and rich tones layered with flavors of fresh strawberry cobbler and bramble accompanied by notes of cinnamon and nutmeg. This wine has rich tannins, nice concentration, depth, and natural acidity)
- 141 Pinot Noir, Flowers, Sonoma Coast, CA.....95**  
(Medium body. Ripe ruby/red in color. Opens with fresh aromas of coastal evergreens and wildflowers. Hints of early-season cherries follow, macerated in warm spices (anise, cardamom, allspice) and layered over earthy sandalwood. Ripe yet tangy dark berries, wearing a little dust from the patch, star on a lightly textured palate, giving way to savory herbs, delicately tannic red tea, and a pop of salty sea beans. A fascinating play of light fruit and dark spice is finished with a bright squeeze of orange peel.)
- 142 Pinot Noir Reserva, Puntis Ferrer, Chile .....54**  
(Pinot Noir Grapes, Cherry-colored with red highlights. Intense nose of strawberry, clove, coffee and toast. Full mouth feel spicy with smoky with toasting notes in the finish.)
- 143 Chateau Charmant Margaux, France.....99**  
(50% Merlot, 45% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Petit Verdot grapes. A bright red robe with brown tints. Aromas of berries, violets, peppers and tobacco. A fleshy texture with full flavors of blackberry, toasted bread and licorice.)
- 144 Echo, de Lynch Bages, France.....147**  
(62% Cabernet Sauvignon, 36% Merlot, 2% Cabernet Franc. Offering pure blackberry and cassis fruit laced with minerals and pressed violets. The palate is medium-bodied with grainy tannin, layers of slightly toasty black fruit laced with tobacco and black pepper, and a fine, cohesive finish.)



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**RED WINE**  
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- 145 Domaine de L'île Margaux, Bordeaux Superieur, France.....62**  
(Cabernet Franc 10%, Cabernet Sauvignon 20%, Malbec 10%, Merlot 45% and Petit Verdot 15%. Beautiful crimson color. Aromas of ripe plum, currants, blackberries and fresh tobacco fill the nose. The palate is medium-bodied with supple tannin and well-judged acidity. There is a pleasant fleshiness here with a salinity on the finish that urges another sip.)
- 146 Chateau Gloria, Saint Julien, France.....155**  
(55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 24% Merlot, 6% Cabernet Franc, and 5% Petit Verdot, is deep garnet-purple in color. Such a deep, concentrated nose, full of ripe blackcurrants and black cherries. Great intensity and concentration on the palate, some dark spicy notes, liquorice, black pepper and cinnamon around the edges alongside layers of juicy and succulent ripe fruit. A full, bold wine no doubt, real power here but stylish and energetic. If you like the gourmet style, this one is great.)
- 147 Cellier des Dauphins, Grenache Syrah Reserve, France.....60**  
(Grenache 60%, Syrah 40% grapes give the wine its deep ruby color. An elegant wine offering rich aromas of black fruit, characteristic of Grenache varietal, combined with spicy notes of Syrah)
- 148 Chateneuf du Pape, le Grand Roi, France.....94**  
(70% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 10% Mourvèdre. With a nice ruby red color, this wine reveals delicate red fruit and blackberry aromas complemented by chocolate notes. On the palate it offers a nice roundness with fine tannins and a fresh and fruity finale.)
- 149 Malbec Unku, Argentina.....50**  
(100% Malbec grape. Medium to full body. Deep intense ruby color. Ripe fruit on the nose. Round and mellow in the mouth, this wine seduces with its fruit and well-matured tannins that bring persistence and finesse.)
- 150 Malbec Grand Reserve UNKU, Argentina.....79**  
(100% Malbec Grapes. Note of cedar, tobacco and spices integrates elegantly with the fruity flavors and tannins of Malbec, creating a wine of great structure and balance.)
- 151 Malbec, Red Schooner Voyage 11, by Caymus.....69**  
(Malbec Grapes. Grapes for this Malbec are grown in the Andes Mountains of Argentina, then chilled and transported by ocean voyage to Caymus, where we use our winemaking techniques to create a style that is dense, dark and supple. Strikingly smooth, with scents and flavors of dark fruit and fine, textural tannins.)
- 152 Zinfandel "Walking Fool" by Caymus, Suisun Valley, CA.....62**  
(Zinfandel grapes. Medium body. Opens with scents of rustic wood, sweet spices, a whiff of cigar, ripe strawberries & cherry. Palate is smooth and lively with flavors of raspberry, cranberry and espresso.)



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## RED WINE

- 153 Barolo Bersano, Piedmont .....70**  
(Nebbiolo Grapes. Full body. Intense ruby red with slight orange reflections. Classic with an intense nose and notes of spice and ripe fruit. Rich and lasting with delicate tannins, traces of leather, licorice and pepper, matched to pleasant notes of withered violet and a hint of prunes.)
- 154 Barolo Terre del Barolo Riserva, Piedmont.....98**  
(Nebbiolo Grapes. Full Body. Aromas of rose petal, forest floor and a whiff of tobacco. The sleek palate delivers crushed raspberry, clove and white pepper alongside lithe tannins and fresh acidity.)
- 155 Barolo Riserva Virna Borgognot,Piedmont.....140**  
(Nebbiolo grapes. Full body. On the palate, its solid structure offers notes of plum, clove, and sage, supported by well-structured tannins)
- 156 Barbaresco Bersano, Piedmont .....66**  
(Nebbiolo grapes. The wine has an intense ruby color with crimson hues. The wine has a harmonious velvety tannins taste with soft shades of liquorice, spices, violets and ripe plums. The aroma of the wine reveals notes of cherry, currant, cocoa and subtle shades of violet.)
- 157 Brunello Petraiolo, Tuscany, Italy.....79**  
(Sangiovese grape. Full body. Aromas of black fruit, ripe cherry, spice, and vanilla bean. A wine of great complexity and balance with elegant fine grain tannins and a firm structure)
- 158 Brunello di Montalcino Eremus, Tuscany, Italy.....90**  
(Sangiovese grapes. Full body. Aromas of intense fruit, well blended with the oak in which it was aged. Elegant and distinctive, structured and firm with ultra-fine tannins and a juicy, delicious and very persistent finish)
- 159 Brunello di Montalcino Reserve Cencioni, Tuscany, Italy.....146**  
(Sangiovese grapes. Full body. Ruby red color with garnet reflections. Floral and fruity, with a particularly evident hint of black cherry and violet, with balsamic and spicy notes.  
Wine with great structure, tannic, intense and very persistent)
- 160 Chianti Classico Orsumella, Tuscany, Italy.....56**  
(Sangiovese grapes. Full body. Ruby red color with garnet reflections. Floral and fruity, with a particularly evident hint of black cherry and violet, with balsamic and spicy notes.  
Wine with great structure, tannic, intense and very persistent)
- 161 Chianti Classico Tomaiolo Riserva, Tuscany, Italy.....60**  
(Cabernet 5% Canaiolo 10% Sangiovese 85%. Medium body. Bright ruby red colour. Intense and characteristic bouquet, fruity with a violet fragrance. Dry and harmonious with notes of dark chocolate and black cherries.)

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## RED WINE

- 162 Amarone della Valpolicella Vecchio Marone, Italy.....79**  
(Corvina 80%, Molinara 20% grapes. Full body. Dark red color with violet hints. Nose of cherry, blueberry, chocolate, and ripe fruits. Juicy, silky wine integrated notes of oak. The mouth is good balanced, complex, with a great length and fruity finish)
- 163 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Almadi, Italy.....89**  
(Corvina Veronese 35%, Corvinone Veronese 30 %, Rondinella 35%. Full body. Grapes are laid down on straw mats to dry until the January following the harvest, when they are pressed. Deep garnet in color, with a rich cherried fruit bouquet and full body, dry and powerfull palate)
- 164 Amarone della Valpolicella Reserve Almadi, Italy.....131**  
(Corvina Veronese 35%, Corvinone Veronese 30 %, Rondinella 35%. Full-bodied and dry with a perfume and palate of ripe black cherry fruit and notes of tar and dark, bitter chocolate on the finish. The grapes are dried under controlled conditions for 3 months until they lose up to 40% of their weight. After crushing, a long slow fermentation takes place in stainless steel vats. The wine is then aged in large oak vats.)
- 165 Sassicaia, Tenuta San Guido, Bolgheri-Sassicaia, Italy.....450**  
(A traditional 85% Cabernet Sauvignon and 15% Cabernet Franc blend, its blackcurranty, dusty, leafy and cedary character is brought into focus by an intense and balsamic palate. It's poised and light on its feet with super-fresh acidity and a fine-grained, almost imperceptible tannic structure. Ripe and tangy raspberry and blueberry fruits linger on the mid-palate, leading to a long, fresh finish with some cream and chocolate notes. )
- 166 Supertuscan Valle Segreta, Italy.....54**  
(60% Sangiovese 20% Syrah 20% Cabernet grapes. Ruby red color with subtle purple hues. Taste of red fruit cherry and blackberry, with notes of tobacco and vanilla from the barriques. Persistent with taste with round tannins.)
- 167 Supertuscan Maremma Toscana Monsalaia, Italy.....62**  
(Blend of Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot grapes. It sparkles with a freshness of fruit and a lively, dancing character. Aromas of dark-skinned fruit and a whiff of cooking spice. The round easygoing palate shows ripe black fruit and vanilla alongside ripe tannins)
- 168 Supertuscan Bolgheri Podere Sapaio Volpolo, Italy.....87**  
(Cabernet Sauvignon 70%, Merlot 15% and Petit Verdot 15% grapes. Full body. An enticing combination of black currant, black cherry, violet, cedar and cigar box flavors highlight. Intense and structured red wine)

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## RED WINE

- 169 Valpolicella Ripasso Superiore Almadi, Italy.....58**  
(Corvina 70%, Rondinella 25%, Molinara 5% grapes. A dry, full-bodied red with a deep and bright ruby red colour. The nose shows the characteristic scent of black cherries and ripe berries with a hint of vanilla and cloves from the oak aging. The palate is ripe and fruity with soft tannins and a lingering finish)
- 170 Montepulciano Reserve Santinumi, Abruzzo .....90**  
(Montepulciano grapes. Ruby red with garnet. Intense and complex, faded flowers, ripe red fruit jam, licorice, black pepper, roasted coffee, tobacco and spices of clove and vanilla. As a body, enveloping, warm with soft and smooth tannins. Long aromatic persistence)
- 171 Primitivo di Manduria, Paolo Leo, Puglia, Italy.....56**  
(Primitivo grapes. Deep ruby color. Enveloping bouquet, intense, cherry and black cherry, pleasantly spicy. Sweet and savory attack, an important and balanced center mouth, lingering finish.)
- 172 Sassarelo, La Lecciaia, Italy.....58**  
(25% Cabernet Sauvignon 25% Merlot 50% Sangiovese grapes. Rich, with earthy aromas of dark cherry, plum, cocoa, and a touch of cedar, and sandalwood. Medium-bodied, round on the palate.)
- 173 Frappato, Alcesti, Terre Siciliane, Italy.....50**  
(Frappato grapes. Ruby red color lightly loaded and brilliant. The nose reveals aromas of red berry fruit, pomegranate and black cherry, with a floral bouquet. The palate confirms the same hints presenting medium-bodied with tannins)
- 174 Cannonau, Castellane, Sardegna, Italy.....66**  
(Cannonau grapes Intense ruby-red color with subtle spice and mature red fruit aromas. Medium-bodied with good structure and a lingering finish.)
- 175 Shiraz Chapel Hill, Australia.....62**  
(This wine displays generous aromas of mulberries, dusted with exotic Indian spices. The luscious palate is brimming with both aniseed and satsuma plum flavours that seamlessly integrate into the persistent mouthcoating tannins.)
