

## JESUS THOUGHT IT NOT ROBBERY TO BE EQUAL WITH GOD

### Psalm 8:5

5 For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour.

*Jesus was not made less or lower in power, he was made lower because he came here to take on a fleshly form – his spirit was encased in a fleshly form which is more limiting than being in a spirit form.*

### Hebrews 2:9

9 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man.

*We still maintain that greater gift from God which the angels desire to look into.*

### 1 Peter 1:12

12 Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.

*Jesus is not lower than God and neither are we ...*

### Philippians 2:5-6

5 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

6 Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

*The religious spirit has always stumbled over Jesus being equal with God ...*

### John 5:18

18 Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, but said also that God was his Father, making himself equal with God.

### Psalm 82:6

6 I have said, Ye are gods; and all of you are children of the most High.

### John 10:33-34

33 The Jews answered him, saying, For a good work we stone thee not; but for blasphemy; and because that thou, being a man, makest thyself God.

34 Jesus answered them, Is it not written in your law, I said, Ye are gods?

### John 10:35-38

35 If he called them gods, unto whom the word of God came, and the scripture cannot be broken;

36 Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God?

37 If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not.

38 But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in me, and I in him.
