Definitions

<u>Knowledge</u>

Dictionary: Knowledge, a knower, or expert, perceive, be resolved, understand. *Strong's Concordance, Greek:* recognition, full discernment

Babblings

Strong's Concordance, Greek: Empty sounding, fruitless discussion, noise, sound or voice.

Surmisings

Strong's Concordance, Greek: Suspicion, conjecture, to think under, privately suppose, deem.

Railings

Strong's Concordance, Greek: Vilification, blasphemy, evil speaking, calumnious against men, impious, against God, to hinder, injure, hurt.

Jangling

Strong's Concordance, Greek: Random talk, idle senseless or mischievous talker, a wrangler, empty, profitless, idle, vain.

<u>Fables</u>
