

THE NAME OF THE FATHER, SON AND HOLY GHOST

(The following scriptures prove that the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost come from and are the name Jesus of Nazareth.)

John 8:58

58 Jesus said unto them, *Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.*

I AM

Exodus 3:13-14

13 And Moses said unto God, Behold, when I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them, The God of your fathers hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me, What is his name? what shall I say unto them?

14 And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

God Almighty/Jehovah

Exodus 6:3

3 And I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by the name of God Almighty, but by my name JEHOVAH was I not known to them.

Salvation

Isaiah 12:2

2 Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH is my strength and my song; he also is become my salvation.

Jesus of Nazareth

Acts 4:10-12

10 Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole.

11 This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner.

12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

Philippians 2:9-10

9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;

(This is the only name by which we are saved.)

The Father, The Word, The Holy Ghost

1 John 5:7

7 For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.

John 1:14

14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

(One God, but three separate personalities or "The Trinity.")

Ephesians 4:4-6

4 There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling;

5 One Lord, one faith, one baptism,

6 One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

John 14:20

20 At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.

John 17:11

11 And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are.

Definitions

Jehovah

Dictionary: To exist, be or become, come to pass, altogether, accomplished, to breathe or to be.

Strong's Concordance, Hebrew: Self existent or Eternal.

(In the Old Testament, several words are used in reference to God; for example, the words Jehovah, Elijah, Emmanuel, and Joshua. Jehovah, through interpretation, has the same meaning as Jehoshua or Joshua. Joshua's name means Jesus; therefore, Jesus and Jehovah mean the same thing.)
