> APPLICATION TO WAIVE/VARY SETBACK – DESTRY OLSEN – GRANDVIEW ROAD

Destry Olsen of 28094 Grandview Road would like to ask the Board to vary the setback from 70' to 50' to put a shop building on his property. Mr. Olsen's property presents issues with flooding so the placement of his proposed building is necessary to prevent future property damage. Director Troxel does not see any issues with granting application to vary setback. After approval from the Board, District Clerk/Secretary Watkins will send them the Notice of Award. Motion made by Commissioner Tom Sells to approve Notice of Award to Thueson Construction, Inc. and authorize signatures for Agreement for Notus Road Intersection Project, seconded by Commissioner Gary Hickman. Motion passed unanimously.

DISCUSS DISTRICT'S PLAN FOR TITLE VI COMPLIANCE
