# ➤ APPROVE PURCHASE OF 2021 CHEVY 1500 PICKUP

Approval is needed to purchase 2021 Chevy pickup from Mountain Home Auto Group piggybacked off City of Boise contract. Motion made by Commissioner Gary Hickman to approve purchase of 2021 Chevy 1500 pickup not to exceed \$35,000, seconded by Commissioner Tom Sells. Motion passed unanimously.
