After years of struggling with epoxies and then super glues (I am not the most dexterous repairman) I have found a product that, for me, works wonders. It is called Cool Chem and is a two part system of "Integrator" and "Activator." The nice thing about this product is that in addition to a conventional application of integrator on one piece, activator on the other, then apply and hold together for a moment, one can also put the integrator on both surfaces, place together, and then spray the activator onto the soon to be glued together item. By capillary action it gets into the integrator and a solid bond results. It is very strong and glues just about everything. This is the link for those interested:




