- Criticism of my partner's opponent will not be made to my opponent.
- Criticism from my partner will be received without a negative emotional reaction.
- Excuses will not be made for my own poor play.
- Criticism of my partner's strategy or poor play will be made only to my partner and only in a constructive manner.
- Recognition will be given to the winners of a match even if hard feelings exist.
- Respect will be shown to tournament directors and referees at all times.
- Appreciation will be shown to tournament host clubs.
- Opportunities for the positive promotion of shuffleboard will always be seized.
