Preparing to host their 4th Bingo together, Barbara reflects on the impact being a Bambie has had on their family, and encourages other alumni to continue to be involved in school events.



Barbara recalls her years at St. Hubert as a special time where she made memories and friends that she will treasure forever. While they were both in their Junior year, Barbara met her husband, Ed, a Father Judge student.

After the St. Hubert community rallied to keep the school open in 2012, Jillian was able to choose to attend, an opportunity both women are so thankful for. In her last 2 years, Jillian took up sewing classes taught by Mrs. Mary Green. In her program, Jillian created numerous designs, including a dress and a coat, participated in the S.H. Fashion Show, and traveled to New York City, where she shopped for supplies at Mood Fabrics. Mrs. Green's mentorship ultimately inspired her to study Fashion Design at Thomas Jefferson University.

Upon Mrs. Green's retirement in 2020, Jillian accepted the job of St. Hubert's new sewing teacher. For the last 5 years, Jillian has balanced being a dedicated teacher and being a designer at American Hats in Bridesburg.

In 2022, Jillian planned a trip for her students to explore various fashion hotspots in New York City. Their trip was financially aided by the first Fashion Bingo, hosted by the Smith family and Mr. and Mrs. Green. The past 3 years, the profit of the Bingo has successfully covered the cost of the sewing class's NYC trip.

Barbara considers herself extremely blessed to share this project with her family and this sisterhood with her daughter. She says, "As Jill's mom, I could not be prouder when I hear how much the students love learning to sew with her."

A Big Off-Field Win for Soccer Bambies

The St. Hubert Soccer Team has just scored a \$5,000 grant to purchase new uniforms.
