THANK YOU SUSAN MULLER ANDERSON (SH'68)

Our Alma Mater is proud to announce a transformative \$1 million gift to fund *The Susan Muller Anderson '68 Performing Arts Center*, a major enhancement to our campus and a significant investment in the future of the arts at SH.

Susan comes from a family with strong ties to St. Hubert—her mother, sisters, and aunts are all fellow alumnae. She and her husband are leaders in the Philadelphia construction industry and dedicated supporters of Catholic education.

The new center will include a fully renovated auditorium with seating for 840, new flooring, state-of-the-art lighting and sound systems, and enhanced stage facilities. It will host student performances, liturgical

celebrations, and community events, and will be available for rental by local organizations—further strengthening SH connection to the surrounding community.

Project work began in mid-May and will continue through the summer with completion by mid-autumn. This project will make a lasting impact on generations of future Bambies.

"We feel it is important to give back to the neighborhood and help the next generation of leaders find their way to a bright future," Susan said.

SHAA TRAVEL SURVEY RESULTS

Thank you to everyone who participated in SHAA's recent travel interest survey. Your feedback is helping us shape future travel offerings that reflect your preferences and priorities.

Respondents expressed interest in both domestic and international travel, with moderate interest in all-inclusive options. Top priorities include value, accommodations, meaningful experiences, and free time. Enhancements like meals, guided tours, and time to explore independently were also important. Most would prefer to travel with

alumnae or guests, and interest increases when trips include familiar faces.

Bucket list destinations include Italy, Greece, and Ireland, with a comfortable price range of \$1,000–\$2,500 per person. There's also strong interest in one-day bus trips from Philadelphia, especially for Broadway shows, local culture, and culinary experiences, with a typical budget of \$75 or more. SHAA will use this input to develop engaging and community-focused travel opportunities in the coming months.
