For her, the trek was more than a bucket list item—it was a journey of self discovery. Toni said this was a true test of mental and physical strength, pushing her beyond her limits. To prepare, for this epic climb, she trained hard and had a total of 586.6km (365 miles!) of hiking under her belt. Every step, she said, was a testament to persistence and determination. The challenges were immense, but the experience, she says, was unparalleled. Toni is grateful for the breathtaking landscapes, the camaraderie with fellow trekkers, and the chance to overcome obstacles at high altitudes. The journey included plenty of moments that demanded strength and resilience and she is thankful for the support along the way and excited for the next adventure on the horizon.
