CHURCH ETIQUETTE

Topic :

As we enter into this new season, what are our expectations of God? Does He have expectations of us? If we want to see great things, we must be prepared to do great things. Church Etiquette helps to ensure worship services and church activities are meaningful and inclusive for everyone present. Church Etiquette supports the spiritual, communal, and respectful nature of worship and fellowship.

Goals:

Reminding the District of basic Church Etiquette practices to create an atmosphere of reverence, respect, and community. The session will give those attending the Planning Session tools to provide similar training at the local church to enhance worship and unity within the local churches.

In this season, may you walk boldly in faith, guided by the Holy Spirit, equipped with divine tools to strengthen and uplift your spirit. Rejuvenation and reinvigoration are available to you as you embrace this new chapter with grace and purpose!

WHAT TO EXPECT...

1. Reverence for Worship - Church etiquette helps maintain a sense of sacredness, allowing congregants to focus on prayer, reflection, and spiritual growth without distractions. It demonstrates consideration for fellow attendees by minimizing disruptions and respecting their worship experience.

2. Show Respect for Others - Church Etiquette governs how the Pastor, Clergy, Stewards, Trustees, Officers, and Components engage with each other and how the laity treats one another. Being who Christ has called us to be, offering ourselves as "living epistles"

3. Honor Traditions and Practices - The African Methodist Episcopal Church has its own unique traditions and practices. Observing proper etiquette ensures these practices are upheld with dignity and respect honoring the Holy Spirit, Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior, and God Our Father.

4. Promote a Welcoming Environment - Good etiquette fosters hospitality, making visitors and newcomers feel comfortable and included, while enhancing their ability to see the best we have to offer as the AME Church - a body of believers, connected all around the world serving in unity.

5. Encourage Unity and Order - Following established practices, in the Discipline, creates a unified standard of worship and organization where everyone can participate in an orderly way, respecting the roles of others.

6. Reflect Personal Values - Adhering to etiquette shows humility, self-discipline, and a willingness to contribute to the collective unification and well-being of the local church, the connectional church, and the church universal.

The Reverend Doctor Paula Lake, an Itinerant Elder in the AME Church, has been preaching the Gospel since 1996 under the power of the Holy Spirit. She is a native of Orlando, Florida and the youngest of six children. Dr. Paula was educated in the public school system in Orlando. She graduated from the University of Central Florida with a Bachelor of Arts Degree and furthered her education at Turner Theological Seminary at the Interdenominational Theological Center in Atlanta, Georgia where she graduated with honors, receiving a Master of Divinity Degree, with a concentration in Church Administration.

She earned the Doctor of Ministry Degree at Ashland Theological Seminary in Ashland, Ohio in Black Church Studies in 2012. During her time in Atlanta, Dr. Paula served as Assistant Pastor at Flat Rock AME Church and later at Greater St. Peter AME Church where she worked in several ministerial capacities. She spearheaded the planning, developing, staffing, and licensing of the Greater St. Peter Child Care Center for children 6wks 5 years old. Dr. Paula relocated back to Orlando in 2001 and joined the staff of St. Mark AME Church, under the leadership of Bishop Samuel L. Green, as the Executive Pastor and Church Administrator. Dr. Paula also served as Church Administrator at Mount Hermon AME Church, Fort Lauderdale under the leadership of Bishop John F. White. Dr. Paula has served alongside her husband of 24 years, Pastor Eddie Lake, in churches in Hollywood, Fort Myers, Miami, and Lakeland, Florida. On October 27, 2023, Pastor Lake was appointed to Alen Chapel AME Church and Dr. Paula serves with him, they are looking forward to doing great Kingdom work in Daytona Beach. Reverend Dr. Paula Lake is the Director of Christian Education for the 11th Episcopal District of the African Methodist Episcopal Church. She also serves on the Board of Examiners for the Central Conference. She is an Adjunct Professor at Southeastern University in Lakeland. Dr. Lake is a sought-after speaker for Women's Conferences and Strategic Leadership training for church leaders. Reverend Dr. Paula Lake is anointed and committed to ministry. She and Pastor Eddie are the proud parents of two daughters, Kalea and Jessica Lake and a son, Edward "Deuce" Lake, II. Dr. Paula holds to the scripture: "... but I discipline my body and bring it into subjection, lest when I have preached to others, I myself should become disqualified." (1 Corinthians 9:27)

Reverend Rebecca Thompson, is an Itinerant Deacon in the African Methodist Episcopal (AME) Church, with roots deeply embedded in both the Baptist and AME traditions, she grew up experiencing the richness of two of the most influential ecumenical ministries in the African American community.

A third-generation minister, Reverend Thompson carries on the legacy. Her grandfather, the Reverend Ossie Banks, Sr. was an ordained Baptist minister and pastor preaching throughout Florida and Georgia; and her mother has served as a licensed exhorter in the AME Church for more than 20 years.

Following this lineage of faith, she answered her call to ministry in 2012, received her license to preach in 2014, and, despite delays, was ordained in 2021 under the guidance of Bishop Adam Jefferson Richardson.

A proud alumna of the University of Florida, she began her theological journey at Turner Theological Seminary, part of the Interdenominational Theological Center in Atlanta, Georgia, in 2022. Her journey as a pastor began on October 27, 2023, when she was appointed to St. Paul AME Church in Winter Garden, Florida—fondly known as “the little church with the big heart.” With a mission to transform lives and perspectives through the love of Jesus Christ, St. Paul AME continues to thrive due to the faithful members who believe you can’t beat God giving!

As the Christian Education Director for the Outstanding Orlando District, Reverend Thompson serves under the visionary leadership of Presiding Elder Milton Broomfield and Consultant Ronda Broomfield.

Beyond the pulpit, Reverend Thompson brings over 25 years of experience in government contracting, specializing in financial and IT services for a leading federal contractor. A dedicated advocate for Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs), Minority Serving Institutions (MSIs), and economic equity through community development, she is a champion for education and empowerment at all levels, for all people.

Through her ministry, career, and advocacy, Reverend Rebecca Thompson is a testament to the transformative power of faith, education, and service. Her greatest hope is that others will be inspired to embrace purpose in Christ and make a salvation-centered impact in their families, churches, and communities...because only what you do for Christ will last.
