

Grand Canyon University Online Classes Overview

Credits and Costs

Grand Canyon University's dual enrollment courses are four credits. Tuition is \$210 per course or \$52.50 per credit. Online courses utilize an e-book with a fee of \$85 per class. Separate textbooks may be required for some online courses (including math courses).

Transferability

Dual enrollment students may take up to 24 credits. The courses transfer into GCU degree programs and students who attend GCU will be eligible for freshman scholarships.

GCU is regionally accredited, so in general, universities that accept transfer credits should accept ours. However, it is at the discretion of the receiving university whether to accept credits for transfer. If you have any further questions or are seeking approvals regarding the transferability of credit, please contact the receiving institution.

Student Qualifications

Sophomores must have a minimum un-weighted high school GPA of 3.25; Juniors and Seniors must have a 3.0.

Registration Process:

1. Complete the free GCU application per the attached instructions (step-by-step outline).
2. Have a **signed, official transcript** emailed or mailed directly from your high school.* Transcripts can be scanned and emailed to dualenrollment@gnu.edu or mailed to:

*All transcripts must be sent directly from the high school to GCU. This includes transcripts provided for home schooled students.

3. Fill out the **Parent Authorization Form** and email back to me at dualenrollment@gnu.edu (required).
4. Fill out the **Credit Card Authorization Form** and email back to me at dualenrollment@gnu.edu (required). Please note, all tuition and fees must be paid before class registration can be completed.
5. Once your transcripts, application, Parent Authorization Form and Credit Card Authorization Form have been received, GCU will process your application, generate a student ID, and provide you with access to our online environment. At this time, technical support will send an email prompting students to reset their password to gain access to their student portal.
