## Makerspace Release Form

This release form documents that the parent or guardian is aware that their student is voluntarily participating in Makerspace time during lunch or after school with knowledge of the risks in doing so, such as the risks of injury or property damage from the use of tools, project's or materials. Tools, games, and equipment in this room (created for students to explore STEM) may include the use of 3D printing, screwdrivers, hammers, art supplies, ratchet sets, soldering equipment (high school only), wrenches, utility blades (high school only), pliers, flying objects (e.g. drones) among other items.

Parents wishing their students to refrain from using a particular piece of equipment maintain responsibility to inform their student which tool he or she can or cannot use and is the student's job to communicate this to the responsible adult at hand where needed. On this note, the Makerspace room is open to inspection or a walkthrough at any point during the PACLU school day for adults to see what is in the room, the various sorts of activities students will be participating in, and options available to them. We are currently looking for additional options for students in the room. Contact PACLU Principal Lucas Fitzgerald for more information.

This Makerspace time will generally be supervised by Pacific Lutheran Jr./Sr. High School, but the school does not guarantee that at all times this room will be monitored by an adult. Parents acknowledge that students inside the room may be recorded in audio, visual and or audiovisual media as an additional option for supervision if an adult is not present in the room.

By signing this form parents acknowledge they have read this Agreement and understand that it includes an assumption of the risk and release of liability. All students participating in the Makerspace time at Pacific Lutheran must complete this release form in order to use the equipment, tools, and activities in the room.

Students agree to use the facilities, tools and materials in a safe way, and parent acknowledge they are financially responsible for any damage due to student negligence of Pacific Lutheran's equipment, tools, or supplies. Students will alert Pacific Lutheran faculty or staff when facilities, tools and material are being used in a way that could cause harm to others. Students will be careful not to waste materials and will clean up after themselves.
