Free to attend



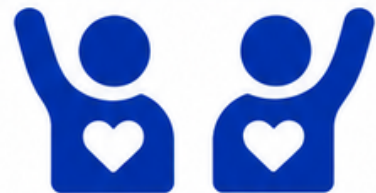
Some host churches may require a signed waiver due to facility policies
