## STRATEGY TO CONTACT US SENATORS REQUESTING SENATE MAJORITY LEADER THUNE TO PRIORITIZE THE SAVE ACT

*The back story and issue*: The SAVE ACTS status and the Complexities of the Senate procedural rules.

- 1. The SAVE ACT passed the House but is stalled in the Senate due to a dispute between Mitch McConnell and Mike Lee.
- 2. The Dispute is over whether the SAVE ACT should first go through the Rules Committee or be placed directly on the legislative calendar. Mitch McConnell is the chairman of the Rules Committee.
- 3. Senate Leadership specifically Majority Leader Senator Thune needs to prioritize the SAVE ACT for the stalemate to be resolved.

## Our Goals are:

- 1. Increase the pressure on Senate Majority Leader John Thune and other Senators to prioritize the SAVE ACT, place on the legislative calendar.
- 2. Call directly the Senate offices rather than emails for greater impact.
- 3. Contact Senator Cruz and Senator Cornyn and Candidate for Senator Ken Paxton to sponsor and committee to the SAVE ACT's passage.
- 4. See list of names and phone numbers to call. We will make weekly calls to all offices. This is going to be a nationwide pressure campaign.
