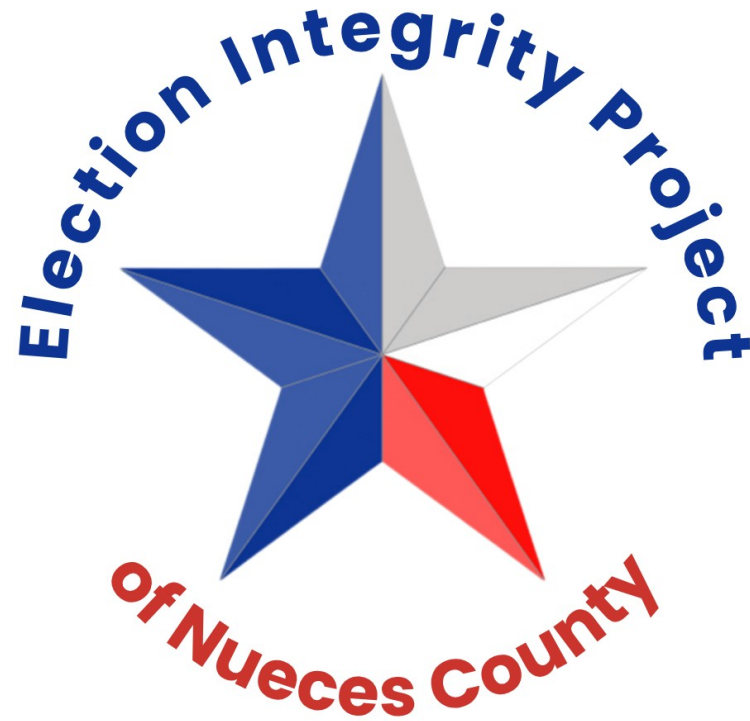
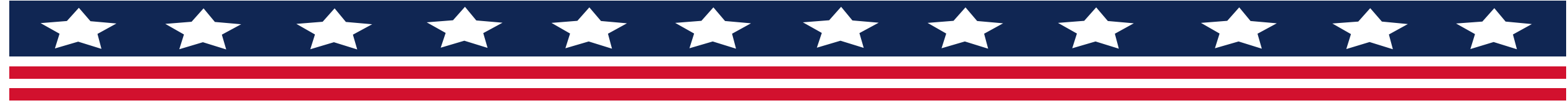

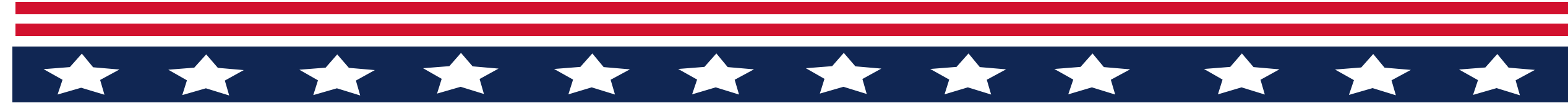

Voter Roll Maintenance Committee Report

- We have completed Age Group 75 with only 8 deceased voters found. That was the last Age Group we will be checking. We will continue checking the recently deceased. Ron Olsson has agreed to help Natalie and I on the recently deceased.
- On 04/15/2026 I requested and received the current copy of the Nueces County Voter Roll. I compared it to all outstanding submissions that have been made to the VR's office. Of the 231 letters that were mailed out to "Moved out of State" voters, so far only 5 have been returned as undeliverable and 71 have been removed from our Voter Rolls which is a 31.4% success rate.



- On 04/18/2026 I gave an introductory training course on ELLY to the EIP Board members and Natalie Olsson at Jason's Deli after the John Birch Society (JBS) meeting. I will be giving another presentation after the next JBS meeting on May 9th at about 10:30am. Our plan is to start educating the community about ELLY's advantages to Voter Roll Maintenance and keeping a clean up-to-date Voter Roll. Hopefully we will be signing up new members for EIP and volunteers to help the VRMC. Our plan is to continue to give this presentation to other local and area groups to show the importance of Voter Roll Maintenance.

- On 04/20/2026 I resubmitted, by email to the Voter Registrar's office, all the remaining items (377) that have been previously submitted but not addressed. I also submitted the Age Group 75 (8), Recently Deceased 0126 (14), Mail Facilities 2 (29), and ELLY Moved 4 (390). This brings the total of deceased voters to 1635 submitted to the Voter Registrar's office for removal.

- We are currently working on a brief presentation to give to Voter Registrar Kevin Kieschnick, then County Judge Connie Scott, and then to the Commissioners Court covering ELLY's potential savings to the County. It will also show the CASS system addresses and their benefits.

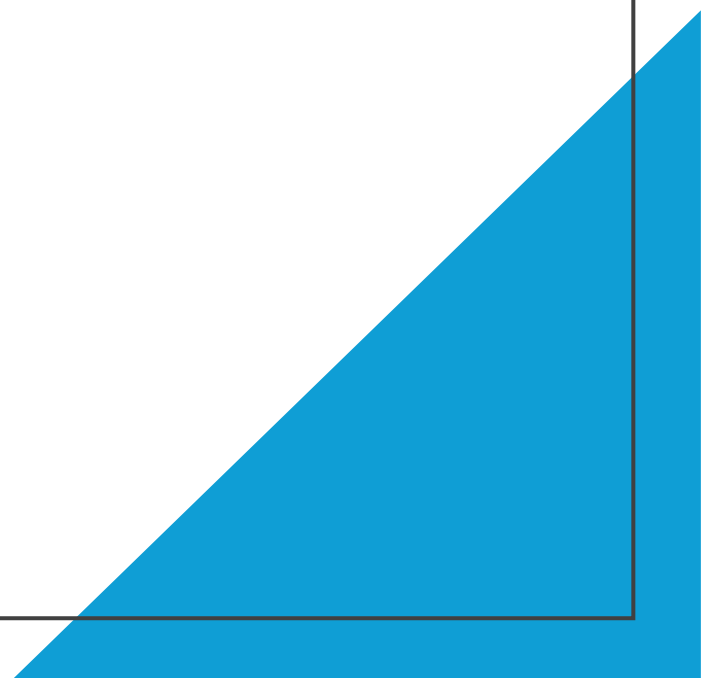

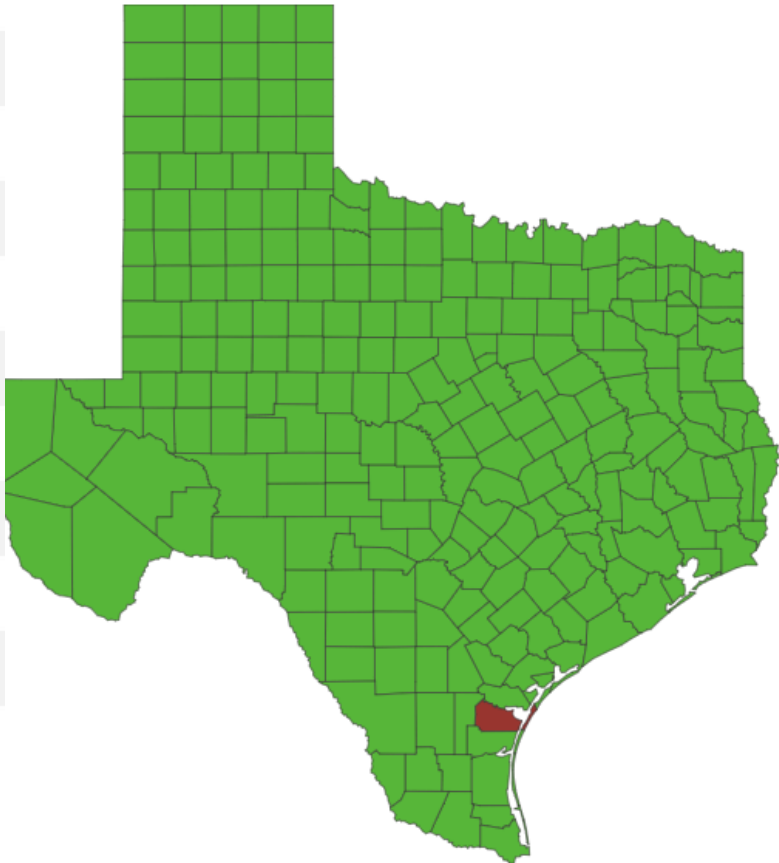

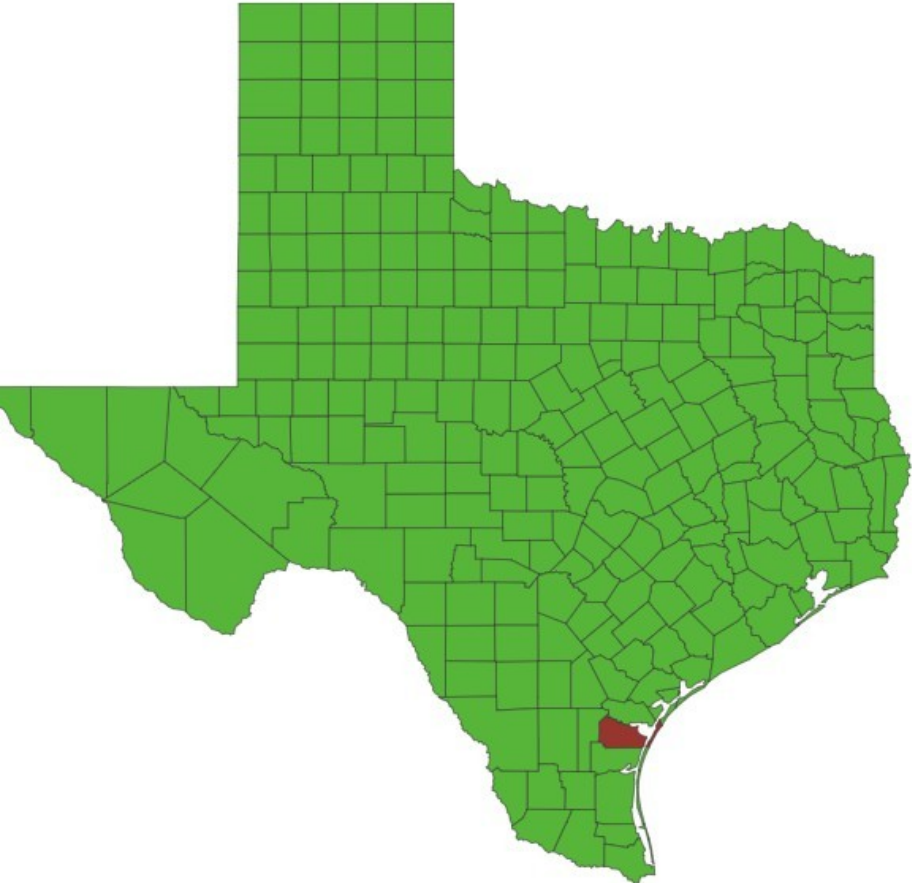
