ELLY Voter Roll Maintenance Software Training

This training provides a practical, step-by-step introduction to the ELLY voter roll maintenance software. It is designed for local citizen volunteers and county employees in the Voter Registrar and Election departments who support voter roll maintenance activities.

What Will You Learn

- How to navigate the dashboard, Cases, Voter Roll, other sections and modules
- How to search, filter, and export voter record lists for review
- How to review key record fields and identify common data issues
- How to document findings, add comments, and track actions submitted
- How to generate reports for internal review and follow-up
- Best practices for quality control, version control, and data handling
