I requested and received a current copy of the Voter Roll on 08-11-2025. After the comparison we had 32 of the 32 80 year old deceased Voters remaining and 60 of the 111 recently deceased Voters remaining for the month of June-2025. I submitted both of these files to Mr. Benavidez in the VR's office on 08-14-2025. We have identified 116 recently deceased voters for the month of July-2025. We have identified 11 recently deceased voters for the month of August-2025 so far. Mr. Benavidez mentioned that the SOS was in the process of upgrading their Voter Roll database for about a month and they were having issues so they could not process any changes until the SOS system is fixed.

We have submitted a total of 1117 deceased Voters to be removed from the Voter Roll.

On 08-17-25 I ran the comparison of the Nueces County Voters with undetermined Citizenship against the current Voter Roll from 08-11-2025 and the total dropped from 5094 to 5081 with 1417 of those voting in the 11/24 General Election (297 in Person, 955 Early, and 165 Absentee).

We are still waiting on Representative Todd Hunter to set up a meeting with individuals from the SOS's office that work directly with the State Voter Roll database but still nothing definite.

I had a short training session on September 27 with Andrea Biery, our newest VRMC member, on searching for deceased voters by age group.
