

# VRMC Update 01/26/2026

On 12/10/2025 I downloaded a list of 273 (222 Active, 51 SUSPENSE) suspected deceased voters in Nueces County from ELLY. It took 3 days to process the list in TPA for tracking purposes. The 222 Active broke down into 175 processed, 16 could not find an obituary, and 17 already processed in TPA. It appears that 4 may have voted after their death but they need further investigation. The 51 SUSPENSE broke down into 47 processed, and 4 already processed in TPA.

I received a copy of the current Voter Roll File from Mr. Perez on 12-18-2025. I compared all outstanding and ready for submissions to the Voter Roll and updated them accordingly. For 0925 of 125 found 28 remained, for 1025 of 123 found 17 remained and for Age group 77 all 22 remained.

I received a Demo PowerPoint presentation for ELLY from Dr. Rick Richards, the brains behind ELLY. I combined my presentation (more of a How-To) with the Demo (the background of future) and presented it to Mr. Kieschnick and Mr. Benavides in the VR's office on 01-20-2026. They both seemed very impressed with what ELLY offers for Voter Roll maintenance at the county level. They both agreed that they could not use ELLY or any other software without the SOS certifying it for their use. The presentation also mentioned Psephos which is made for the SOS administration side of Voter Roll maintenance which they asked for a presentation covering it's features. Mr. Kieschnick asked me to contact him in early February to discuss a meeting with him, Denise Villalobos and Adam Hinojosa about ELLY and Psephos. I presented 313 deceased (285 from ELLY) for removal from the Voter Roll. We have submitted a total of 1526 deceased Voters to be removed from the Voter Roll.

ELLY went live to the public on 01/24/2026. I reprocessed 264 obituaries (previously done in TPA) from the Obituary Module and submitted them into the Submission Module. The Submission Module will eventually become the VR's Inbox so most all of our submissions will be done this way in the future. Hopefully soon we may be processing Deceased and Moved Voters in ELLY and submitting them into the Submissions Module for the VR office. No more printing the obituaries and proof of moved voters and then setting up meetings when it is timely for the VR's office, the submissions will be in their inbox and they can process them whenever they have time.
