I requested a current copy of the current Nueces County Voter Roll on 10-10-2025 and received it on 10-14-2025. After the comparison on Age group 79, 26 of the 26 identified still remained. The comparison also showed 18 of the 122 0725 recently deceased identified still remained, 32 of the 134 0825 recently deceased identified still remained, and 55 of the 125 0925 recently deceased identified still remained. All of these will be presented to the Voter Registrar's office after the current election. We have currently identified 76 recently deceased voters for the month of October-2025 (1025) and 8 for the age group 78.

Natalie Olson found another duplicate registration but the individual only vote once in the Nov-24 General Election. The Nueces County VR's office has resumed using their old database system due to issues of compatibility with their new system and the new SOS TEAMS 2.0 database.

We have submitted a total of 1117 deceased Voters to be removed from the Voter Roll.

The SOS finally compared the 454K potential non-citizen Texas voters to the governments SAVE database and 2,724 non-citizens were found on the Texas Voter Roll. There are a total of 41 found on the Nueces County Voter Roll. These 41 were sent from the SOS to the Nueces County Voter Registrars' office on 10-16-2025.

I spoke with Representative Todd Hunter today (10-27-2025) and he is setting up 2 meeting with individuals from the SOS's office that work directly with the State Voter Roll database. The first will be a zoom call after the Constitutional Election to set the groundwork and the 2nd meeting will be an in-person meeting to better discuss the issues and their progress in addressing them. Also, several Texas Election officials have requested that, due to the issues the SOS is having with their roll out of TEAMS 2.0 database software, they halt the roll out until their issues can be addressed.
