 3. Grey bottoms with a black button-up top (no jacket).
 4. Black bottoms with a grey button-up top (no jacket).
- **Shoes:**
 - **Comfortable footwear is recommended.** If wearing high heels, consider a comfortable backup option for long periods of standing or walking.

For Men

- **What to Wear:**
 - Button-up shirt (white, black, or grey based on the selected combo).
 - Dress pants (black or grey based on the selected combo).
 - Optional: Jacket (if required by the selected combo).
 - Nametags will be provided.
- **What NOT to Wear:**
 - T-shirts, polo shirts, or casual shirts.
 - Jeans, cargo pants, or shorts.

For Women

- **What to Wear:**
 - Button-up shirt (white, black, or grey based on the selected combo).
 - Dress pants or skirts (black or grey based on the selected combo).
