

Steve Pester, Network Manager for Diné Adventist Radio (DAR) sends this update: "We continue to wait for NTUA (Navajo Tribal Utility Authority) to connect power to the KDHP tower on Black Mesa, near Piñon and Chinle. The required permit was delayed in the Bureau of Indian Affairs during the government shutdown. Although calls to Senators, Tribal Officials, and Supervisors initially stalled, now that offices are open again, we are following up daily to secure the release of this permit."

JESUS BEE HOZHO



The November 2025 issue of “Navajo Waves” featured the Diné Adventist Radio program , **JESUS BEE HOZHO**. The program name in English is “The Wellness of Jesus”. This program is “one of the most popular programs” being aired by DAR. It is more than a broadcast; it is a lifeline of hope, healing, and harmony for those Navajo listeners seeking wholeness and prayerfully, finding it in Christ. Two licensed counselors -- Tamara Peshlakai and Tim Pearson – produce the program.

“TAMARA PESHAKAI”

In her interview with “Navajo Waves” PHSDA’s own Bisti Broadcasting board member, Tamara, describes God’s leading in her life and how the doors have opened for her to engage more fully in ministry. She states, “I have been able to support Diné Adventist Radio, host the **Jesus Bee Hozho** radio program, help at DAR events, lead Bible studies, facilitate in-home care groups, and offer Christian counseling and coaching.

“Inspired by God’s faithfulness, I now... find joy in helping others experience healing and spiritual growth. The vision for a mental health radio program began when Pastor Dale Wolcott introduced me to another licensed counselor, Kim Pearson. He shared my passion for integrating spirituality with mental and physical health—an approach I believe is God’s providence.

“The name **Jesus Bee Hozho** comes from the Navajo word *Hozho*, meaning “walking in beauty,” harmony, or wellness. In this context, it reflects the truth that true harmony and well-being are found in Jesus. Our program seeks to reach those who may not seek help elsewhere, showing how a relationship with God brings both healing and growth.”

“KIM PEARSON”

Kim’s report to “Navajo Waves” stated, “Out of the blue, Pastor Dale Wolcott contacted me. We had met a couple of years earlier, and he remembered that I had worked on the Pine Ridge Reservation as a social worker, something he had also done. To my surprise, he had kept my contact information.

“Pastor Wolcott told me about Tamara Peshlakai and the possibility of a radio program. What he didn’t know was that I had long carried a desire to use my years of trauma work to serve Native communities in a deeper way. When he called, I couldn’t say no. It was more than coincidence, I recognized the hand of God, directly answering the desire He Himself had placed in my heart.”
