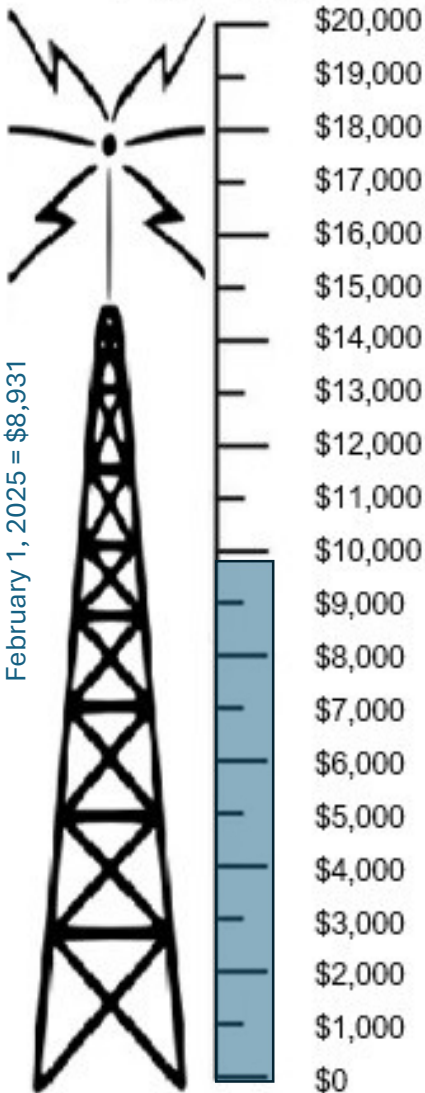

## "GO YE...COME YE"

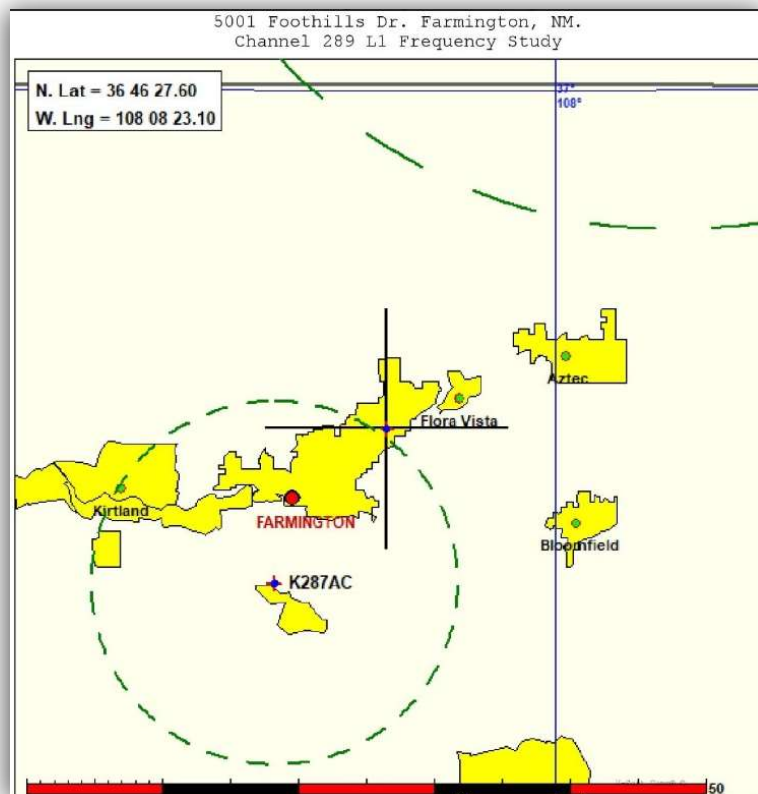

### NAVAJO NATION RADIO NETWORK OVERVIEW

Bisti Broadcasting, located at Piñon Hills SDA Church in Farmington, NM will be one of the Low Power FM stations which will extend the coverage of the Diné Adventist Radio (DAR) programming. Two additional LPFM stations in Shiprock, NM and Window Rock, AZ have received FCC Construction permits. The DAR network of three full power FM stations will cover the central part of the Navajo Nation and the LPFM stations will bring the signal to populations which are on the outer edges. The Full Power stations are licensed to Good News Broadcasting Network of Phoenix Arizona. Once the full-power and low-power network is completed, there will be a potential 103,000 Native American listeners plus online listeners outside the station coverage area.

KDHH 89.5 FM is the first of the three DAR stations to reach completion and go on the air. It was up and running on January 1, 2025. This was only six days before their FCC (Federal Communications Commission) “hard” deadline. Many miracles contributed to the timely completion of the fully funded station. The engineers were able to successfully test the station signal for a few hours before pausing broadcasting until completion of all necessary technical documents. This station tower is located at Kaibito, AZ on Preston Mesa. Kaibito is a census-designated place in Coconino County, Arizona made up of approximately 300 families with 99.2% Navajo population.

KDHP 91.9 FM will be the largest of the three stations and is licensed to the town of Piñon. Broadcasts from this location will cover the Chinle Valley and the heartland of the Navajo Nation. The 199-foot tower located on Black Mesa will broadcast to 31,000 potential listeners. Funding is almost complete and construction is expected to take place in the next few weeks.

KDHG 90.9 FM will be located in Gallup, NM, just outside the southeast corner of the Navajo Nation. The programming will reach 23,000 potential listeners including Gallop’s majority Navajo population as well as large populations within the reservation. The tower site at the All Nations SDA Church property is awaiting funding for the \$329,000 potential budget. A proposal requesting part of the funding from a major donor is in process. The DAR broadcasting studio is located in the Gallup All Nations SDA Church property.

The DAR project started as a dream five years ago and God’s workings have brought it to this point. The Navajo Nation encompasses territory in the Arizona, Nevada-Utah, Rocky Mountain and Texico conferences and in three Union conferences: Mid-America, Pacific and Southwestern unions.
