Earnest prayers were offered for God to protect the shipment and to decrease the worry. What we didn't know was that God had a plan that involved the PHSDA Elder's phone!!

Tuesday morning Ron Price received a call on the Elder's number that a delivery needed to be made to the church address. Ron asked if they could deliver to his residence instead. The shippers said YES!




RADIO COMMUNICATION
