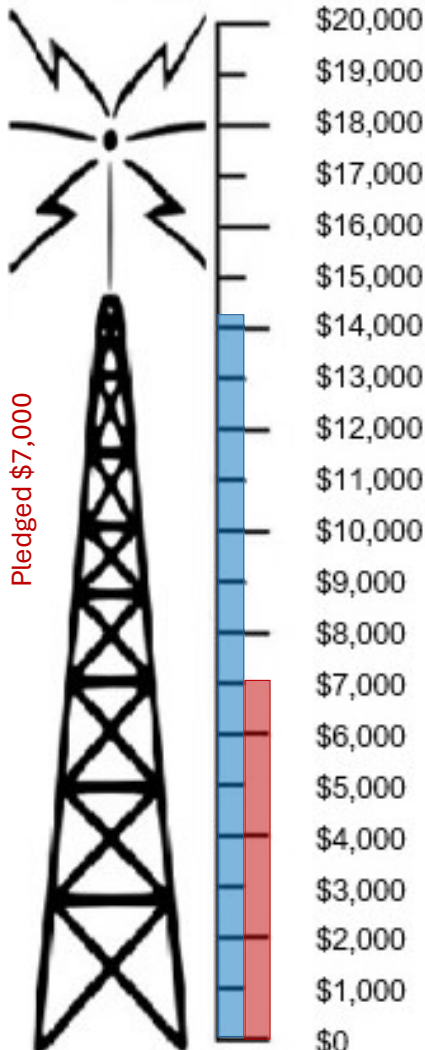
A summary of the developmental stages of BISTI BROADCASTING:

- >>October 19, 2023 local churches received word from the Rocky Mountain Conference of possible involvement with Diné Adventist Radio network as a local Low Power FM Station
- >>Approval by PHSDA Church board to explore the establishment of a Radio Corporation Board made up of five PHSDA members
- >>Radio Ministry Board formed and station development began
- >>Retention of the services of an Attorney to work on our behalf
- >>Expedited incorporation process in the State of Delaware since New Mexico was not able to meet the application deadline required by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC)
- >>FCC application filed by our Attorney on the final application date – December 12, 2023. Meeting this deadline was a miracle! Another chance to apply would not come around for an estimated six to eight years!
- >>Receipt of the Federal Communications Construction Permit on February 9, 2024 – Valid for 36 months.
- >>The FCC Permit gave evidence that God was leading and generous contributions toward the needed \$20,000 started flowing in.
- >>Re-Incorporation process to move corporation to New Mexico
- >>Acquiring 501(c)(3) Charitable Organization rating
- >>Filing our application for the station Call Sign from the FCC
- >>Receipt of call sign - KBFH-LP/105.7 Choice of the slogan "Keepin' Bound for Heaven" based on the call sign!
- >>Filing of Initial Business Operation Report for New Mexico

At this point, all seemed "Well Done". Our engineer, Jim Burt of Broadcast Technology Associates, Inc. obtained a broadcast supply quote for our start-up equipment. The supply company needed a Nontaxable Transaction Certificate (NTTC) to avoid charging us sales tax. At that point we found out that we needed a New Mexico Business Tax Identification Number (NMBTIN). So one more application! Now, we have our NMBTIN and are awaiting word from Adventist World Radio concerning their possible donation of either cash or equipment. We will then place our equipment order from the broadcast supply company. Praise God for funds contributed and for progress!! Keep Praying! Thank you to PHSDA and Aztec SDA for earnest prayers and generous contributions.

- ❖ Travel Budget for Diné Adventist Radio Program Director, Kenneth Kirtley, to take portable recording equipment to reach producers in remote areas.
- ❖ Abundant financial support for building and operating this powerful radio ministry to the long-neglected, unreached Navajo people group which is the largest reservation and largest tribe in North America.
