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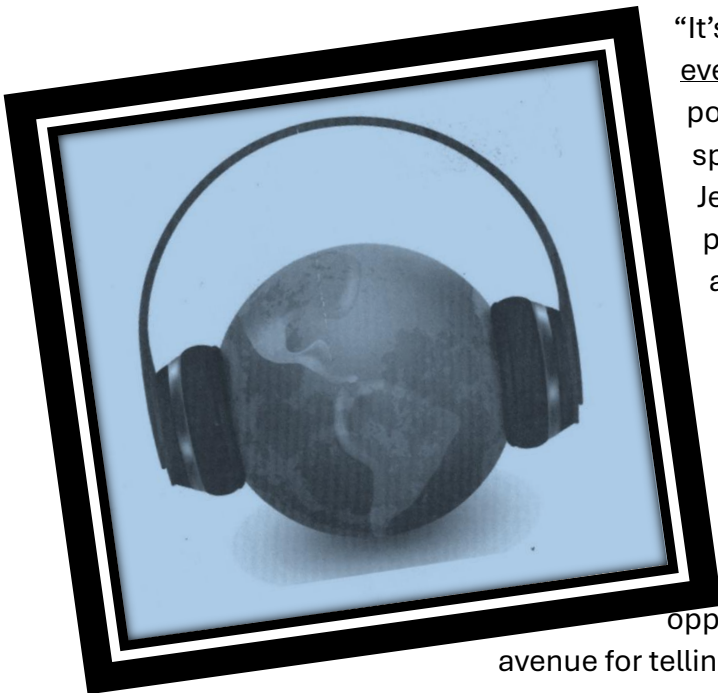


Consider the following question asked in the Summer issue of the newsletter from

On May 14 our engineer, Jim Burt, and our construction contractor, Jedekiah Coy, both arrived from Colorado to put the final connections and finishing touches on the tower. They then connected the tower to the computer system and assessed the tower's performance.

Every system indicated readiness for the build-out of the broadcasting software and pulling the switch to go "ON THE AIR".

Sammy Gregory, Adventist World Radio engineer, will return to the Four Corners area within the next few weeks to finalize programing and start up for Bisti Broadcasting and three other LPFM stations!
