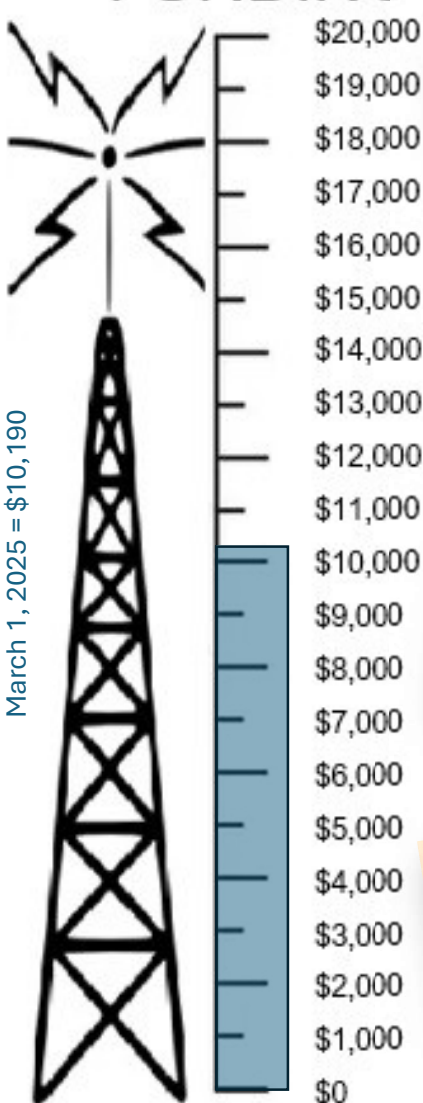

JOHN PARLE of Tower Signals, Mountain View, Arkansas - Back in late 2023 and early 2024 the consulting engineer's study to be submitted to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) was done by John. He was one of four consulting engineers suggested by our attorney, Don Martin. John was very kind to us in his pricing and his work on our behalf met all of the FCC requirements, resulting in approval of our construction permit in February 2024. We appreciate John's continued suggestions and encouragement to our project.

JIM BURT of Broadcast Technology Associates, Durango, Colorado – Finding a local construction engineer presented a challenge! Jim was recommended by Scott Michlin of station KSJE from San Juan College and by Brian Williams from ComTekk Engineering in Taos. However, both recommendations were accompanied by the warning the Jim was in the process of retiring and might not be able to help us. We prayed! We contacted Jim and he said “yes” to our request. He has met with our board and done a survey of the facilities. He will continue to work with us as funding for equipment purchases becomes available.
